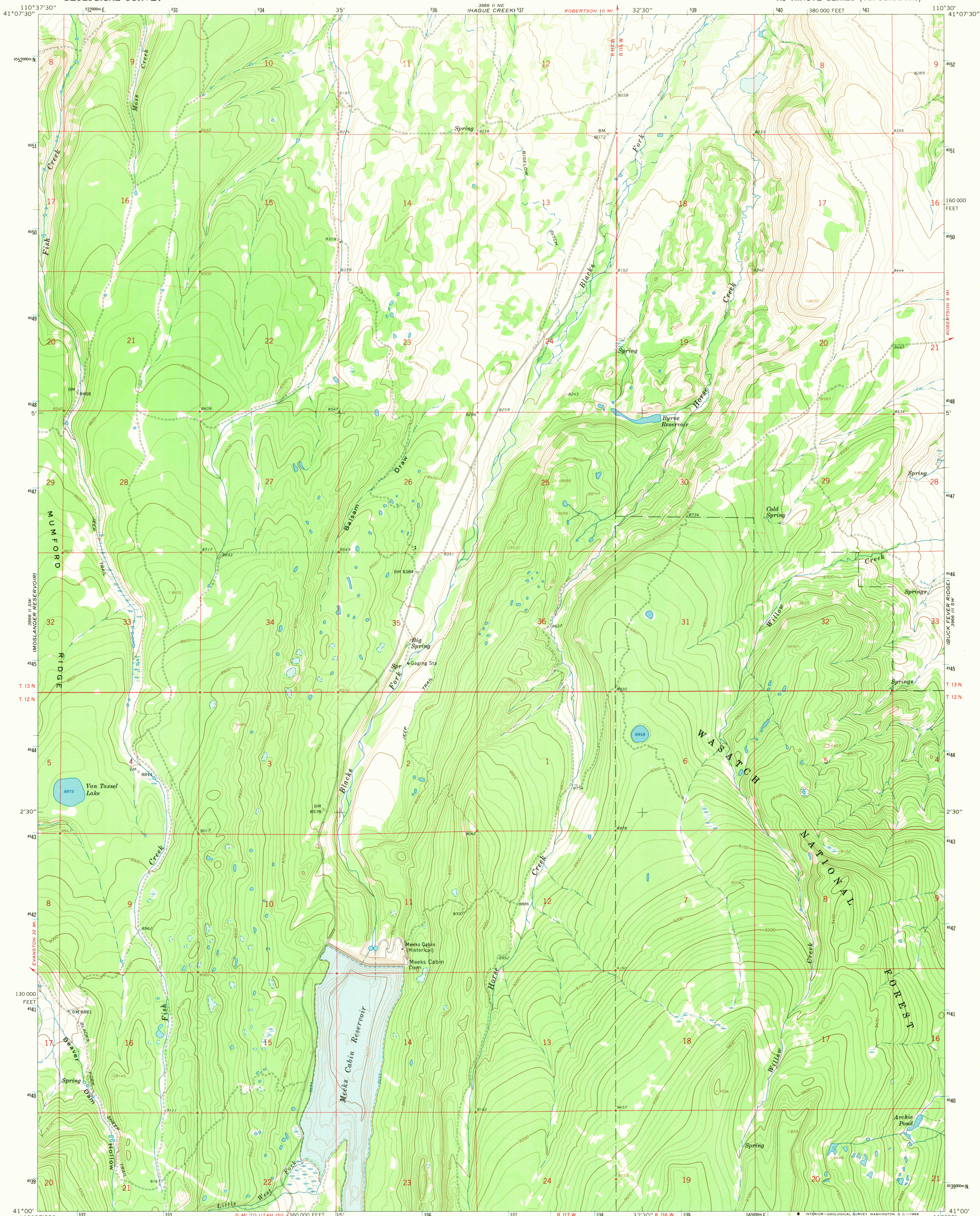

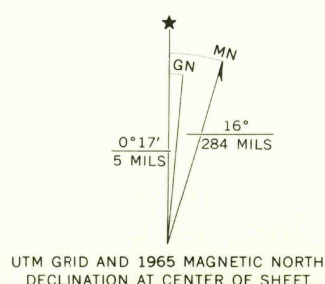

west zone

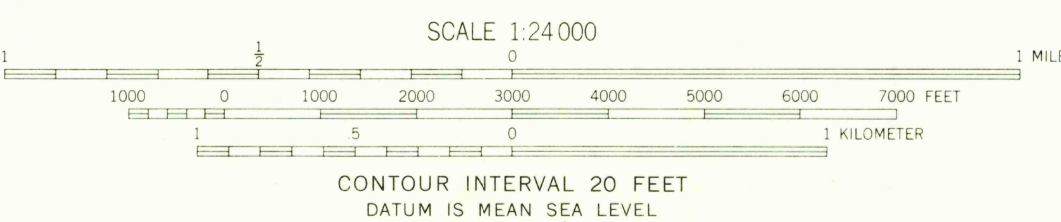
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

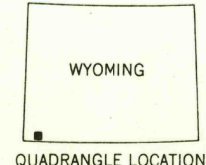
Blue hatched area is proposed Meeks Cabin
