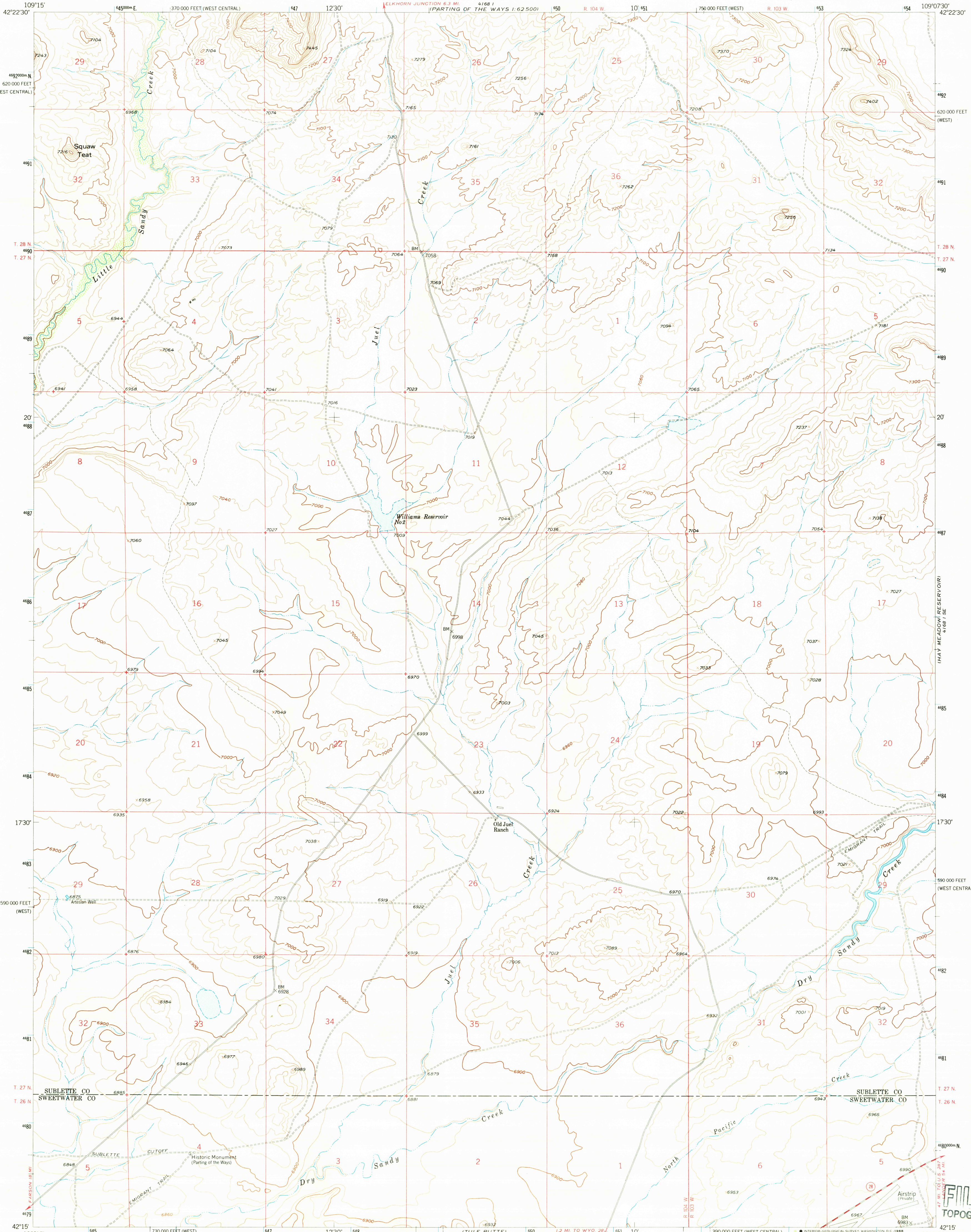

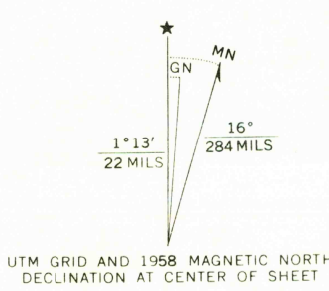

10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, west and west central zones

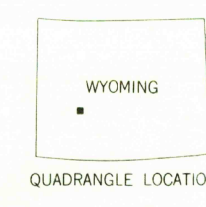
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue
