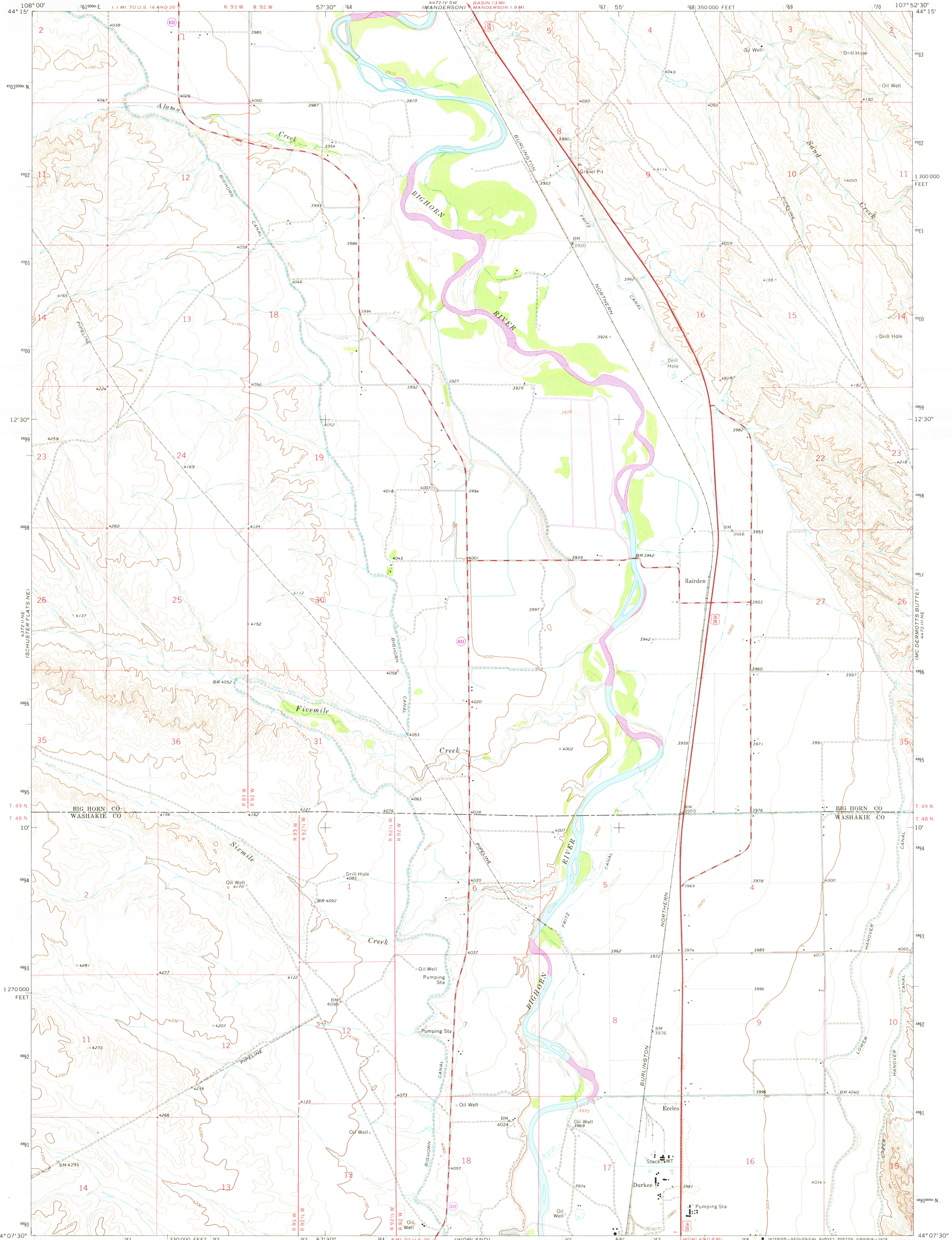

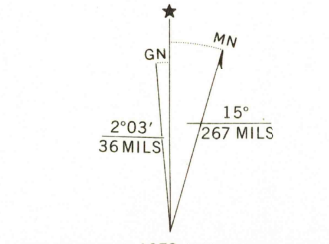
10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, east central zone

Revisions shown in purple compiled from aerial photographs taken 1976. Map edited 1978. This information not field checked

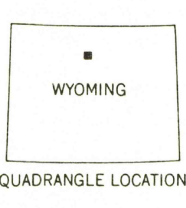
