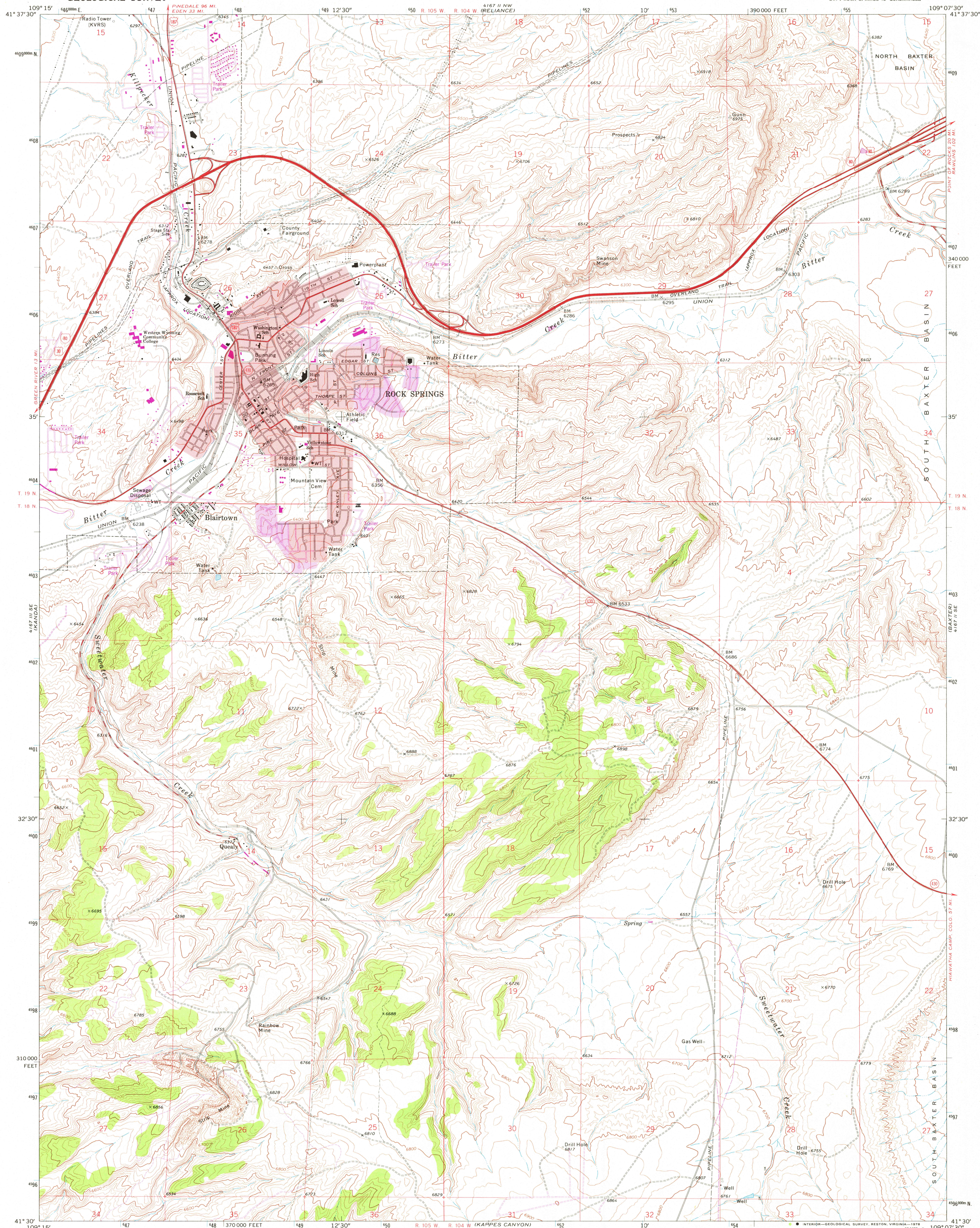

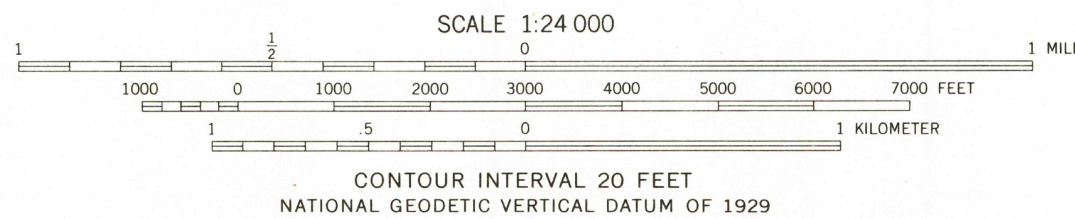
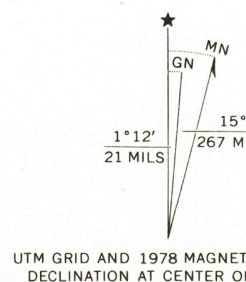
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, west central zone

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

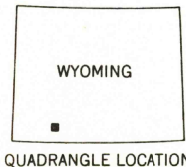
Purple tint indicates extension of urban areas
