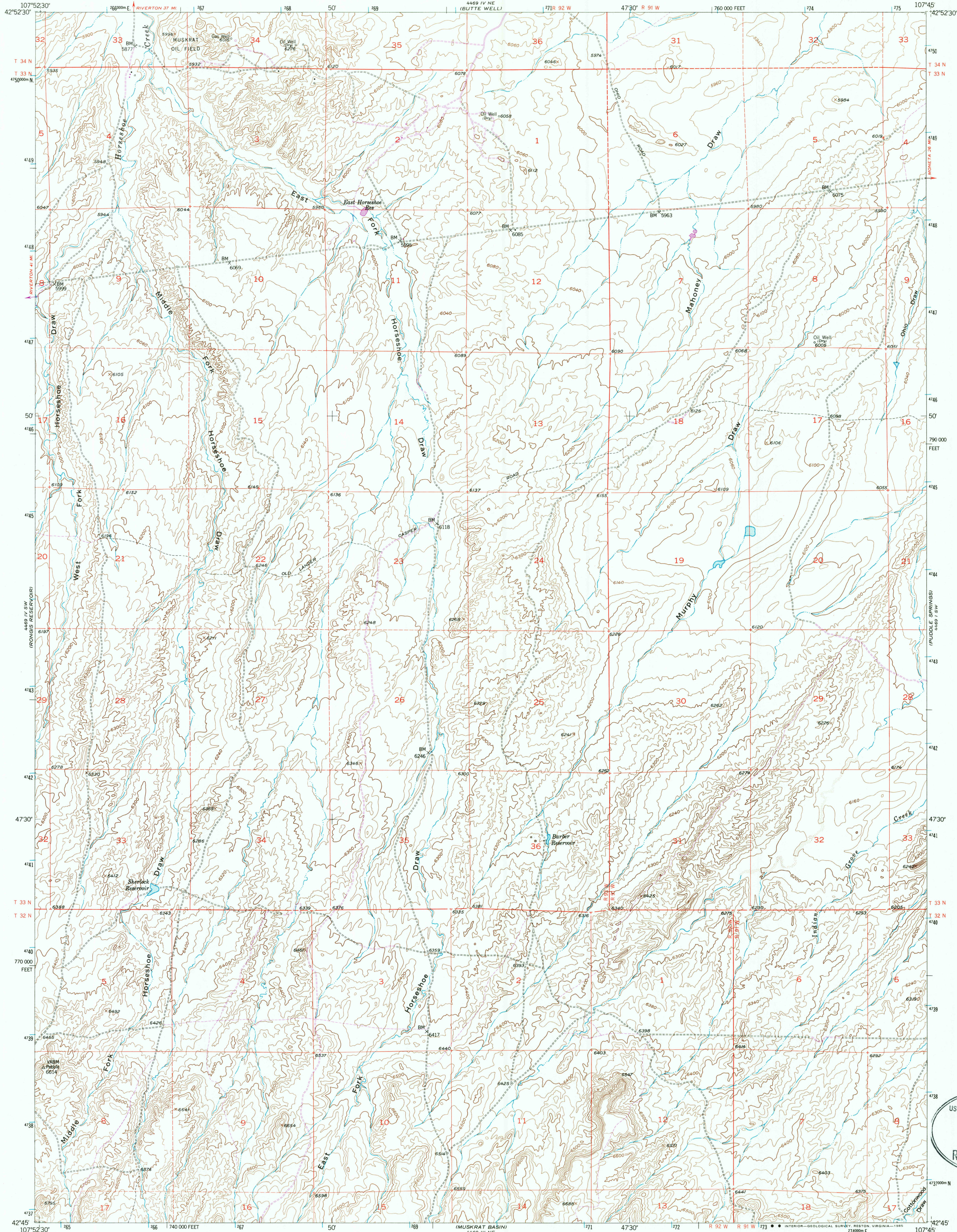

Topography from aerial photographs by multiplex methods. Aerial photographs taken 1949. Field check 1952.

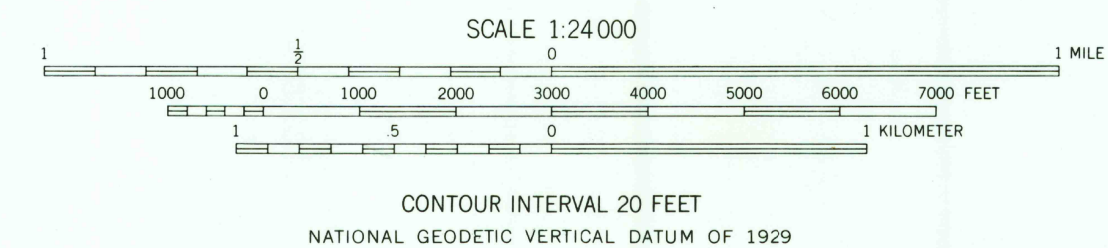
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, west central zones.

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations.

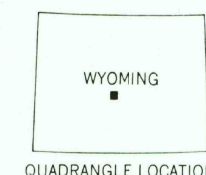
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue.
