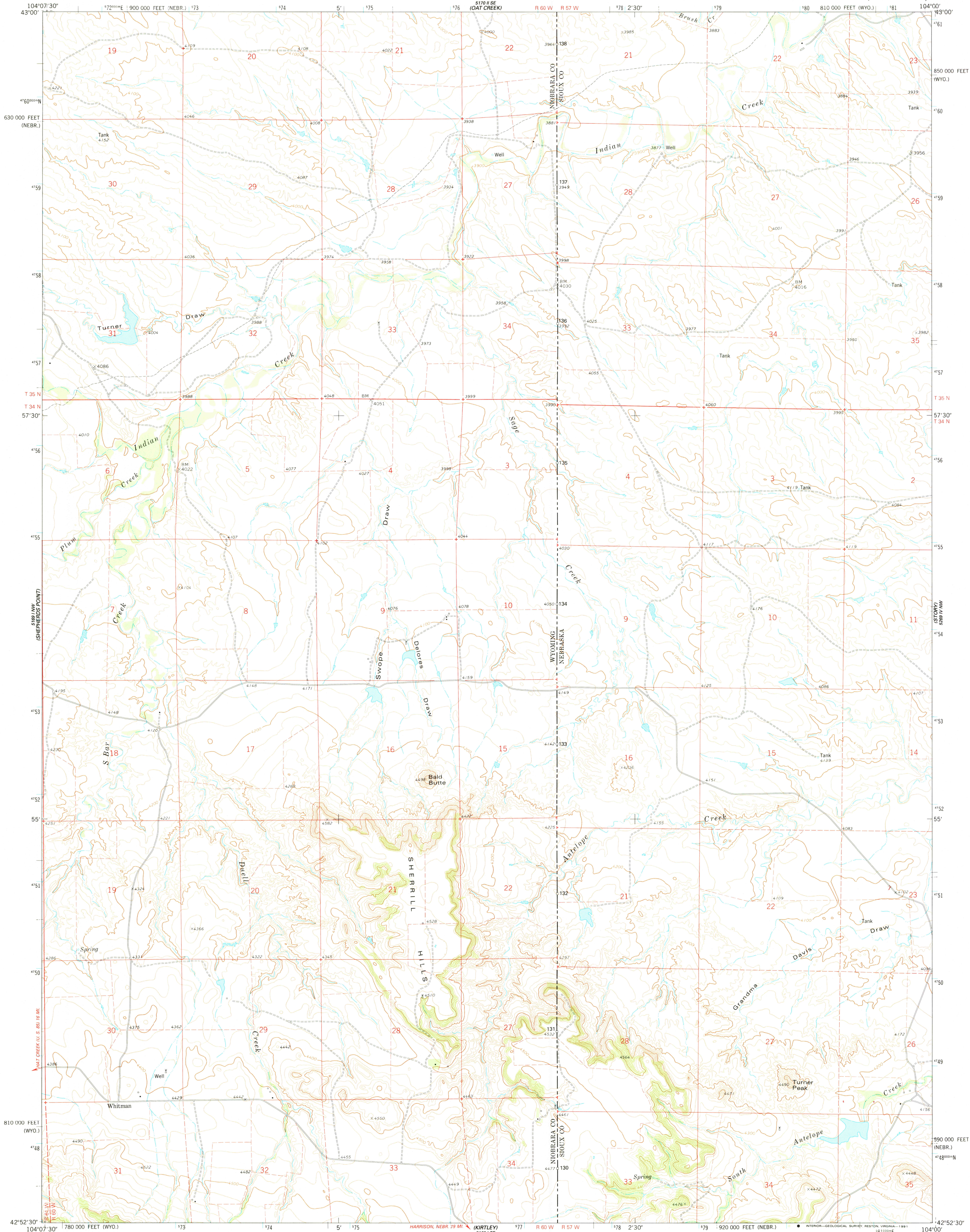

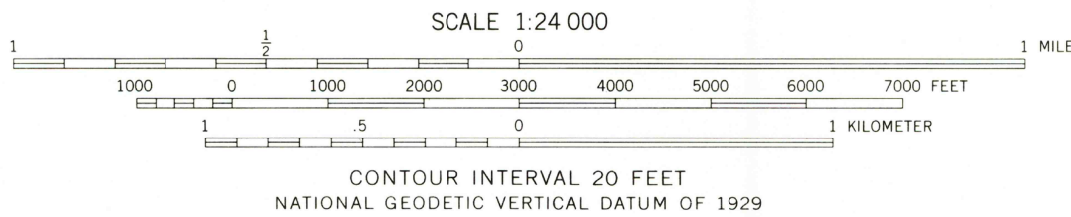
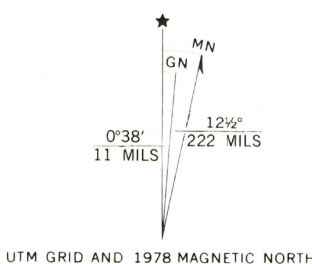
SHERRILL HILLS QUADRANGLE

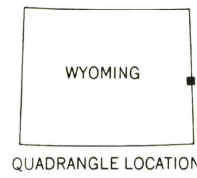
