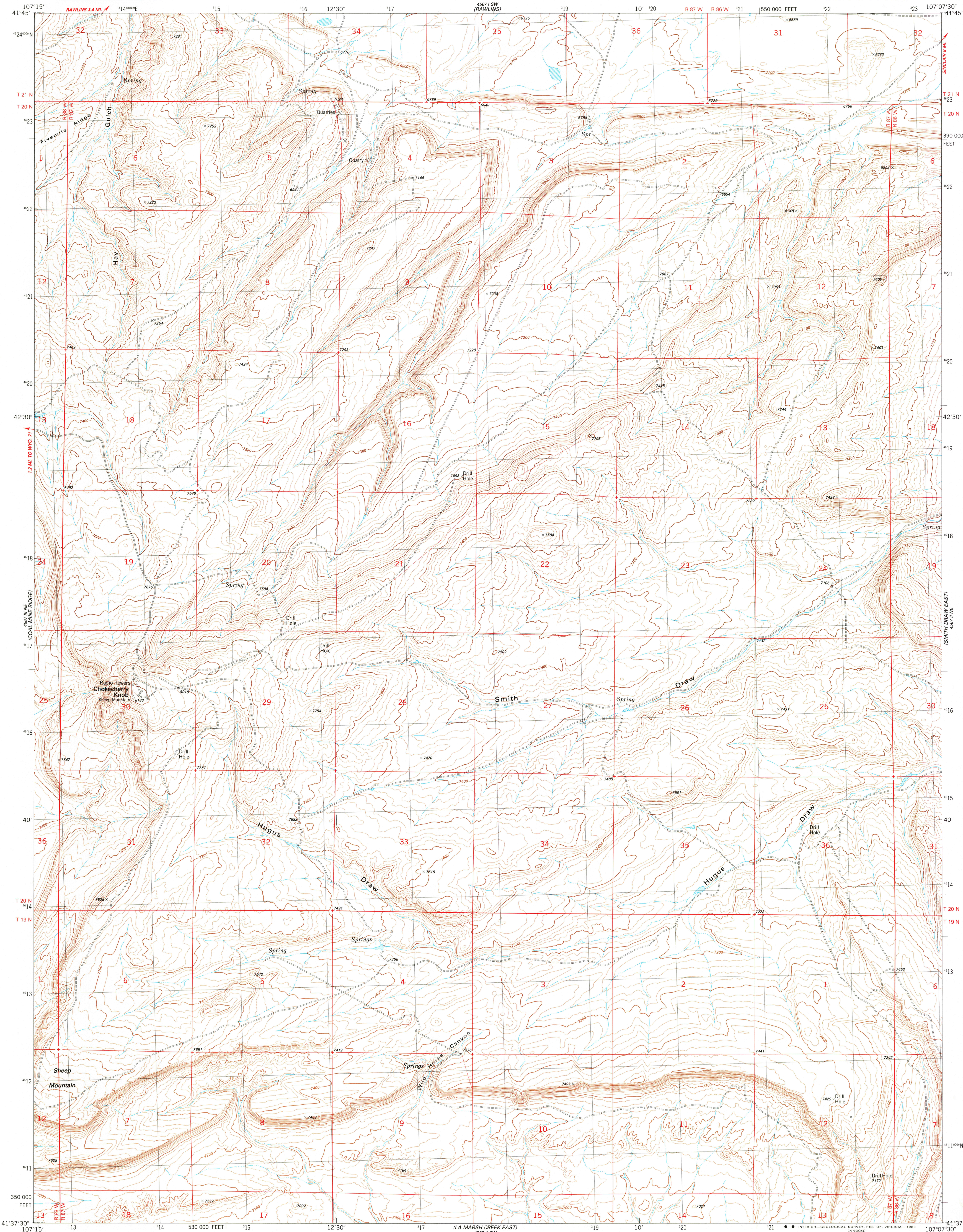

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 13

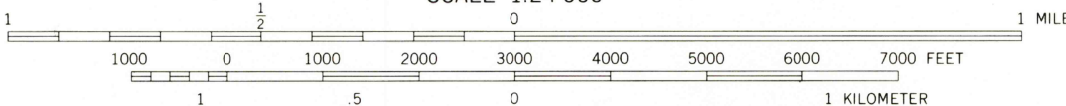
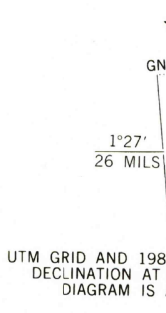

move the projection lines 7 meters north and

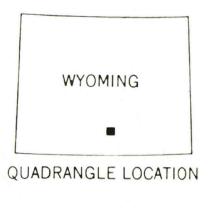
52 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
