

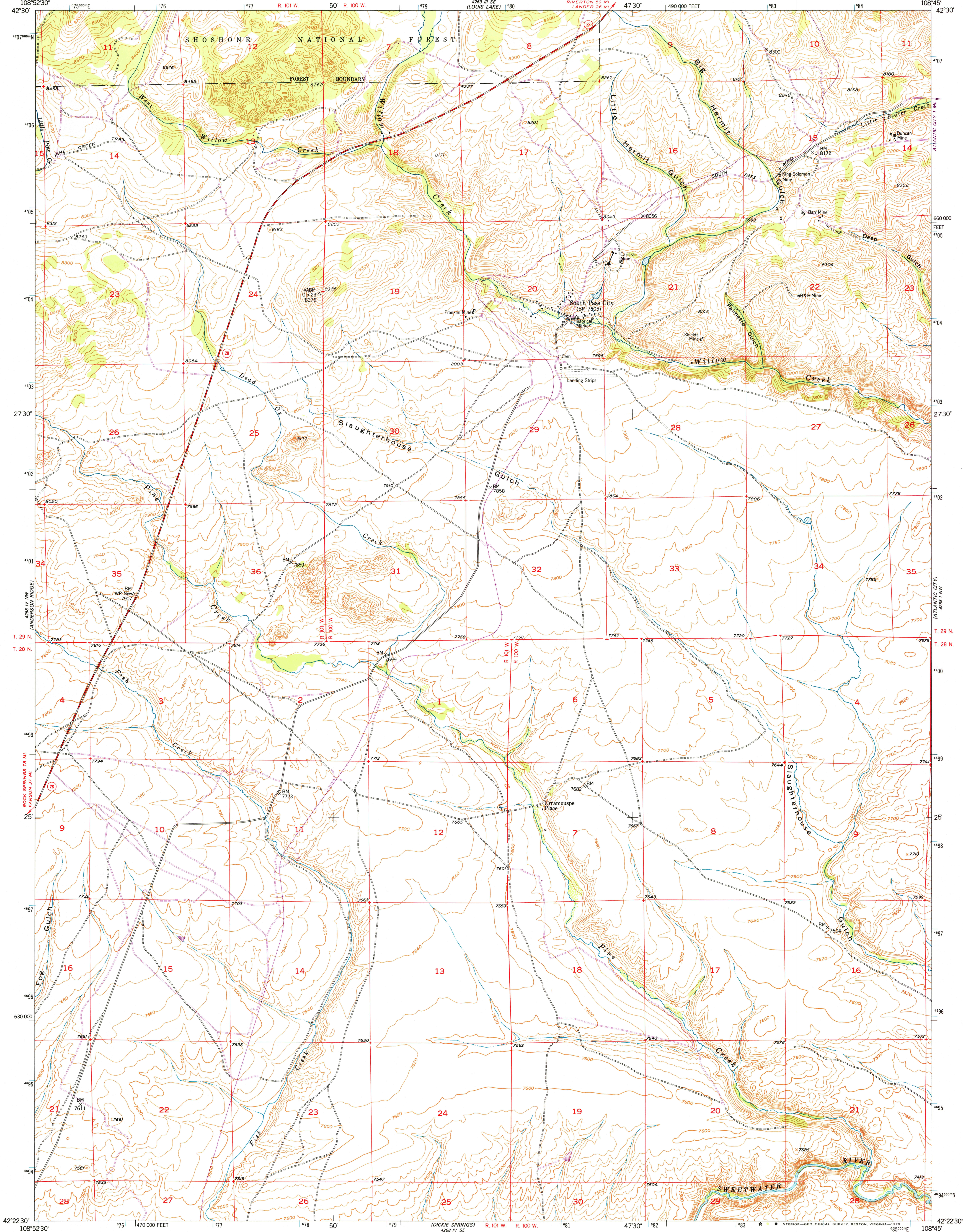

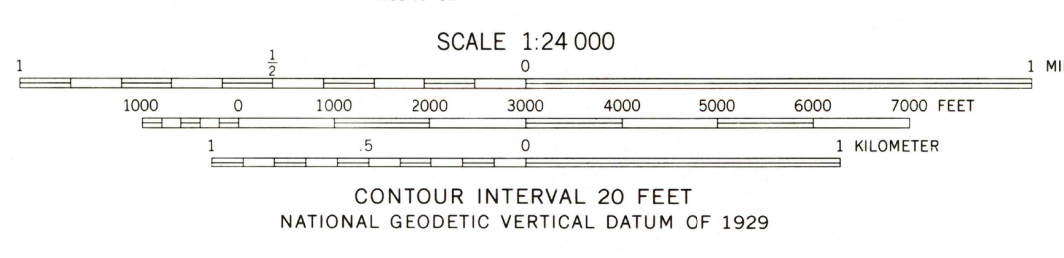
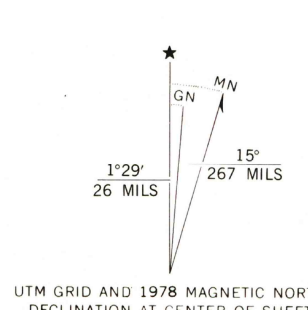
SOUTH PASS CITY QUADRANGLE
