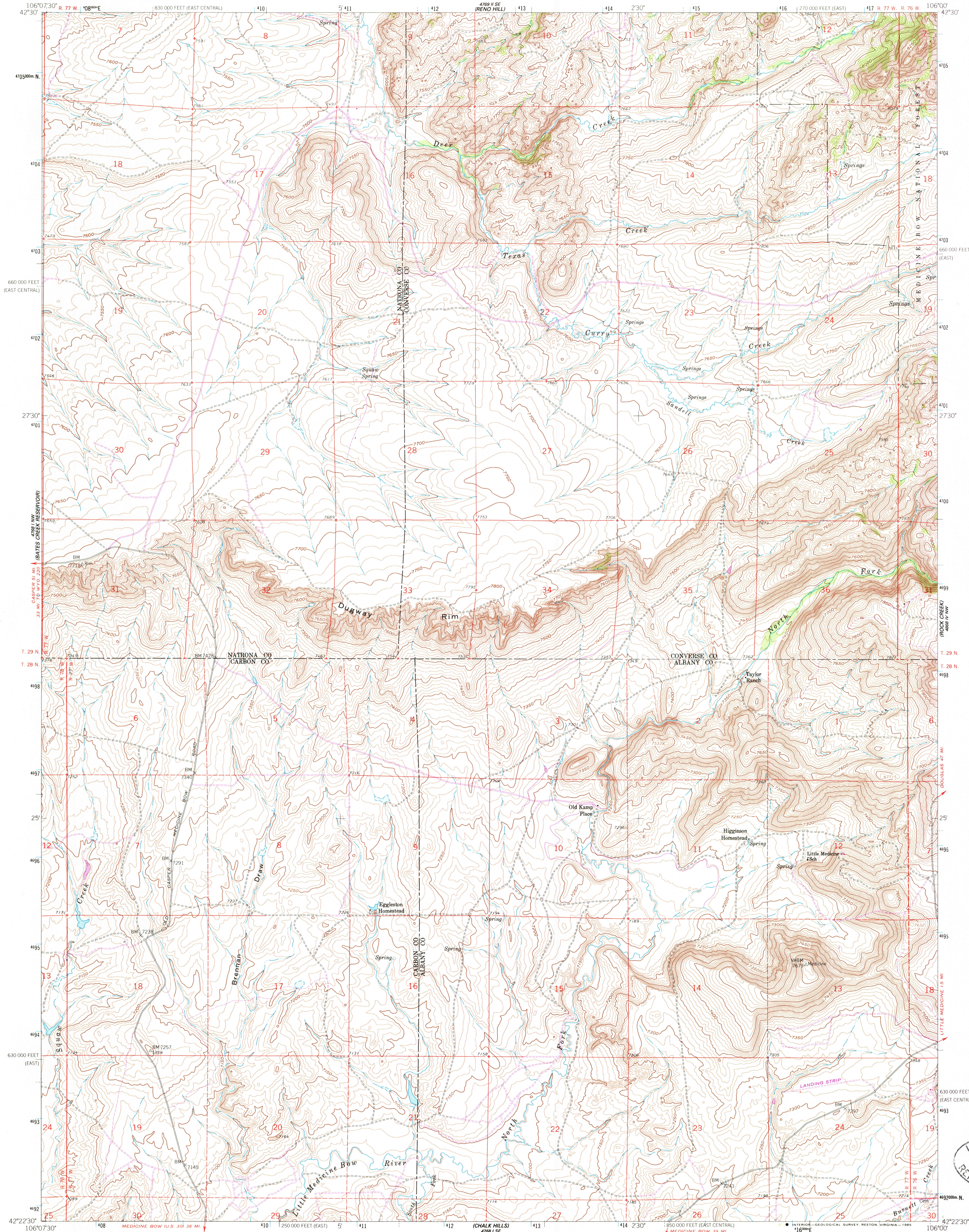

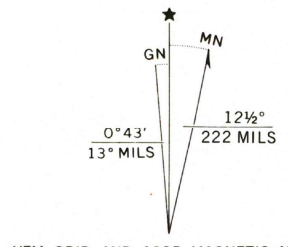
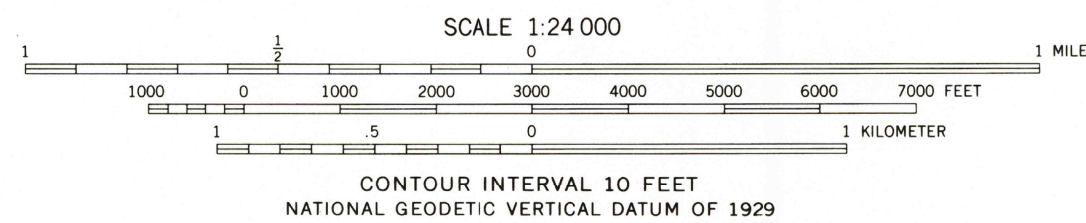
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations

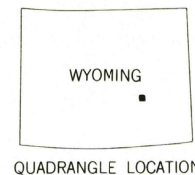
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines
