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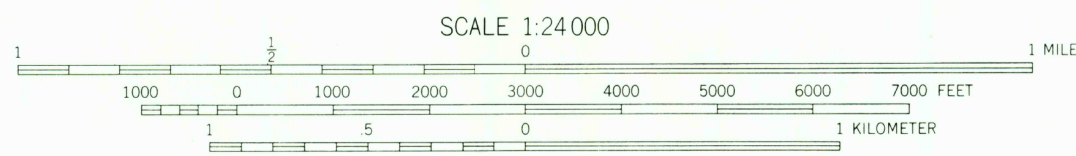
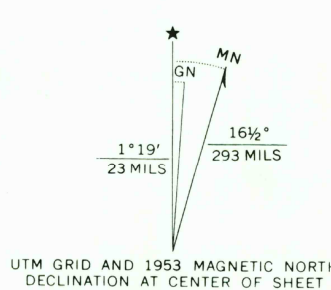

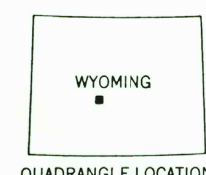
10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, west central and west zone
