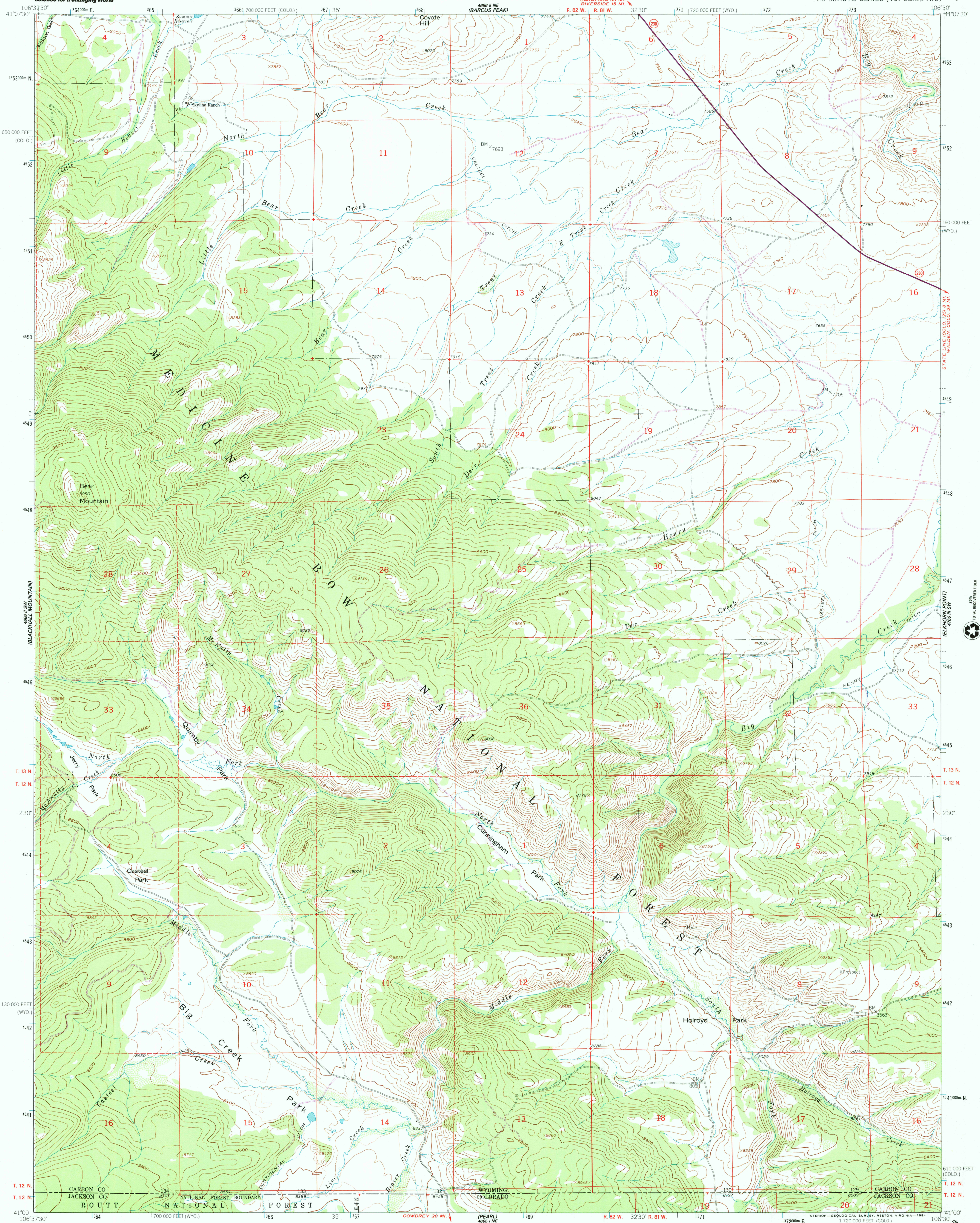

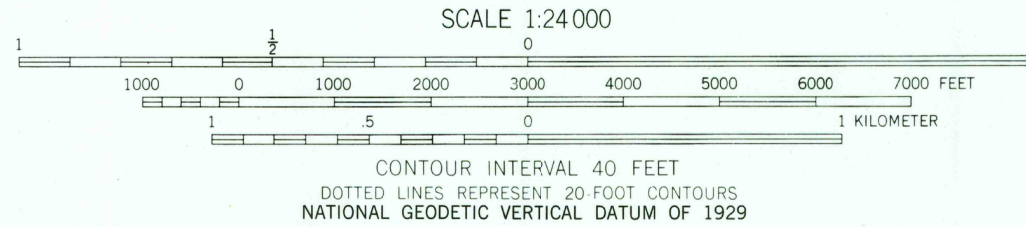
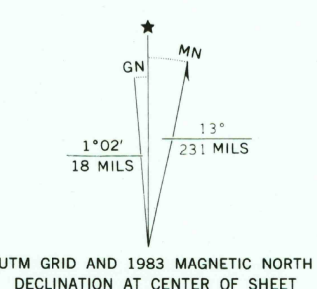

Where omitted, land lines have not been established or are not shown because of insufficient data

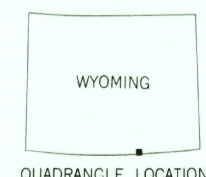
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
