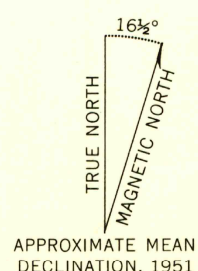

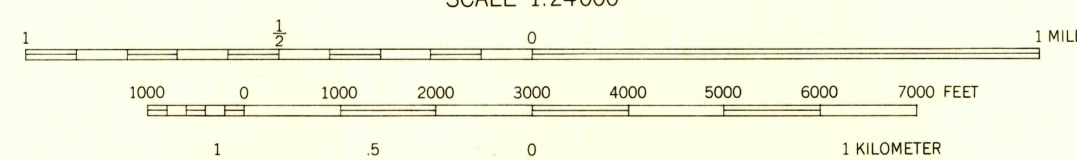

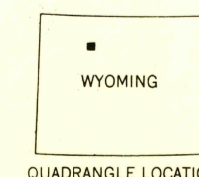


APPROXIMATE MEAN
