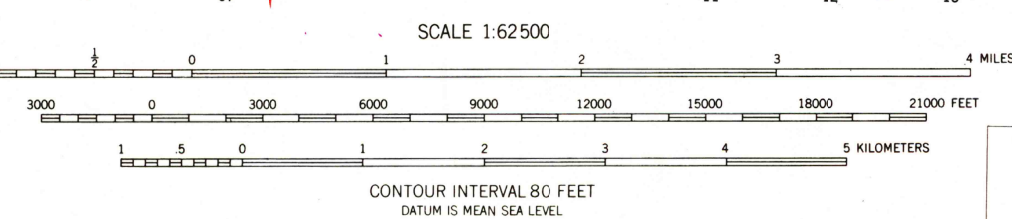
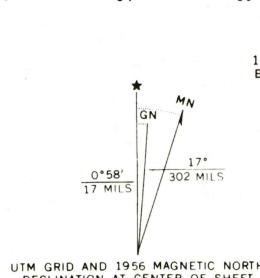

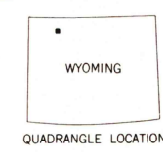
DEAD INDIAN PEAK QUADRANGLE
