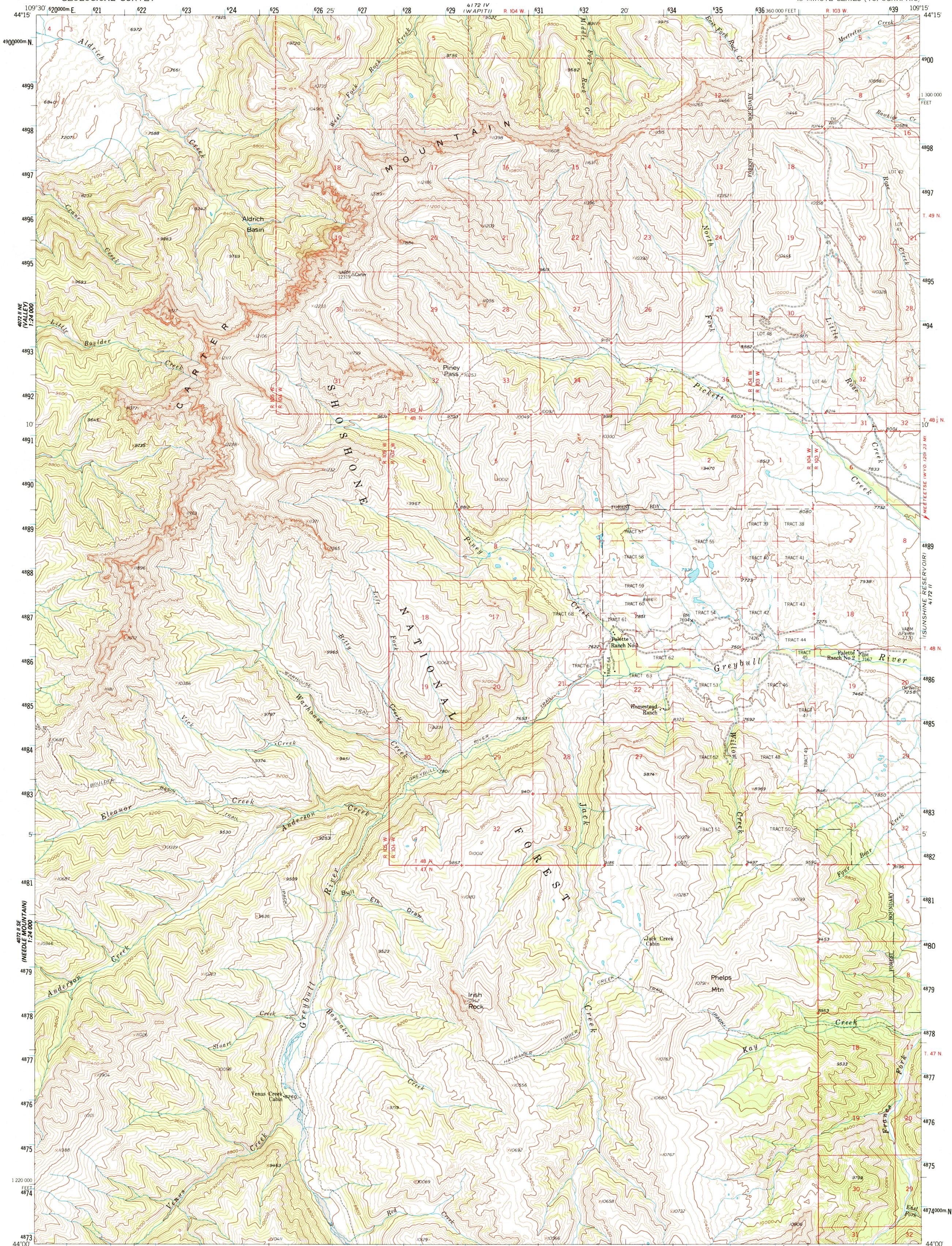
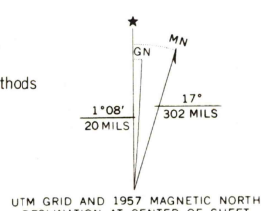

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15 MINUTE SERIES (TOPOGRAPHIC)

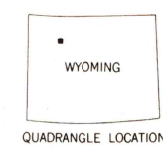

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, west central zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue. Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations. Land lines unsurveyed in Ts. 47 and 48 N.-R. 105 W. and in parts of T. 49 N.-Rs. 104 and 105 W. Land lines omitted in T. 47 N.-R. 104 W. because of insufficient data. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 9 meters north and 56 meters east. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
