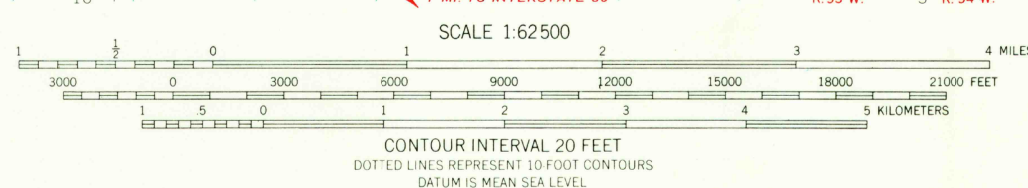
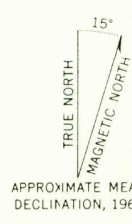

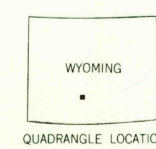
LOST CREEK BUTTE QUADRANGLE
