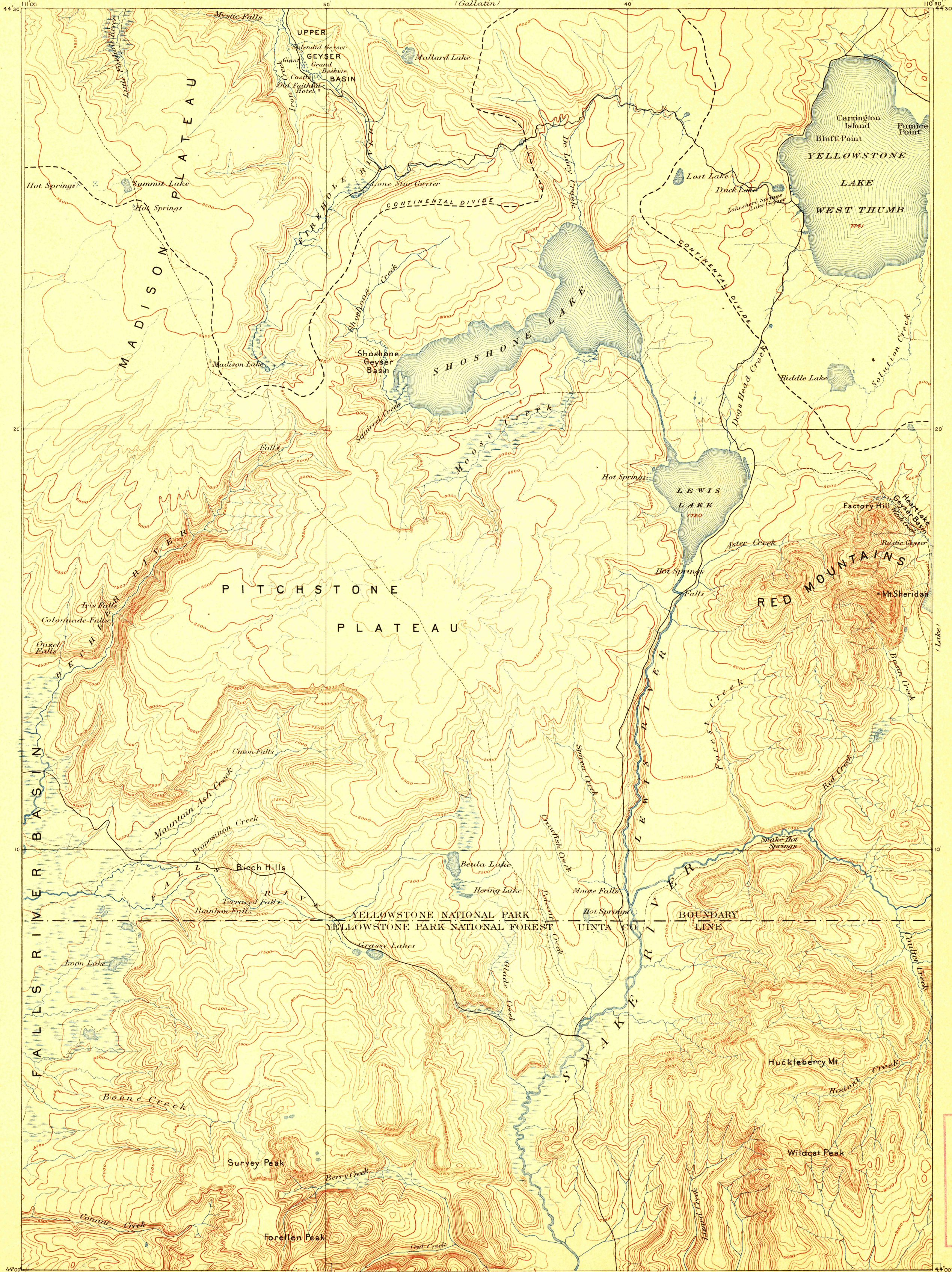

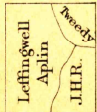
YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK-WYOMING
