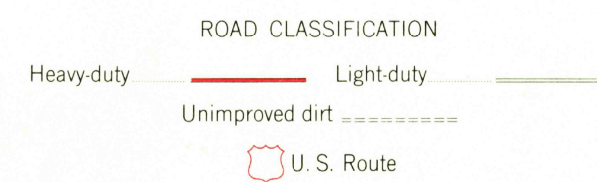
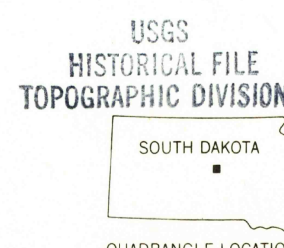
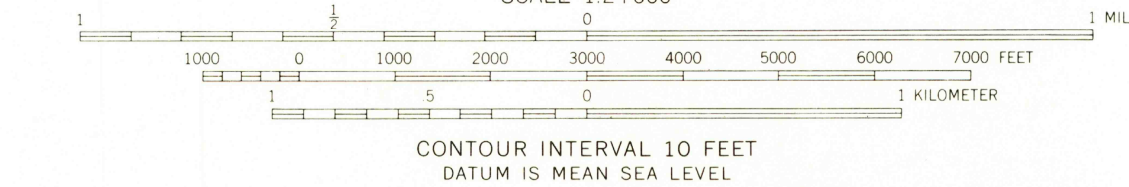
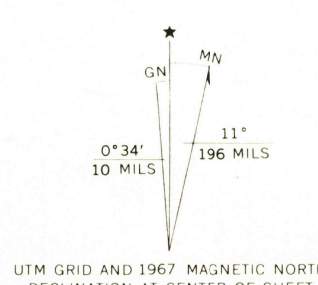
BLUNT SE QUADRANGLE
