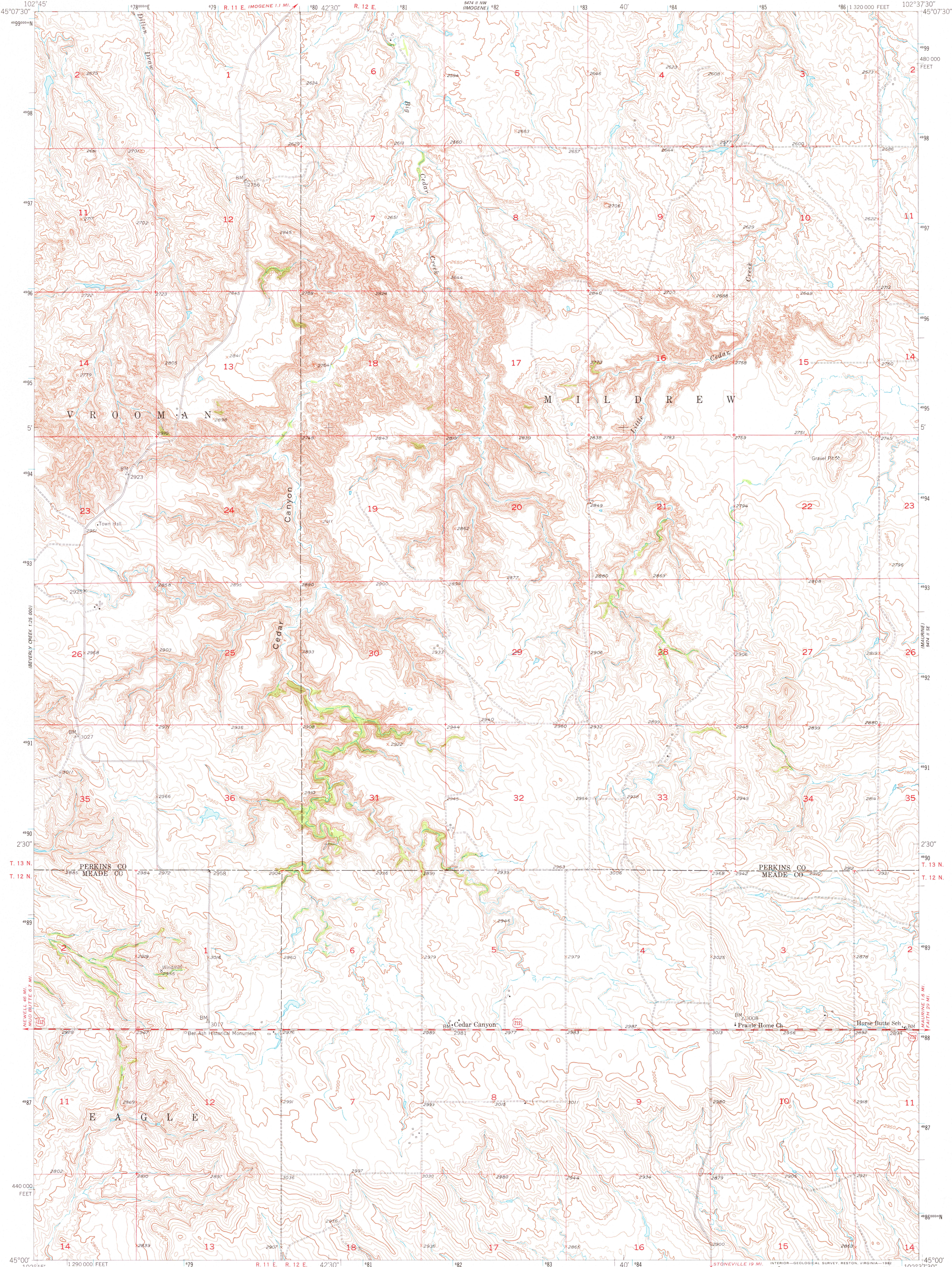

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 6 meters north and 39 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
