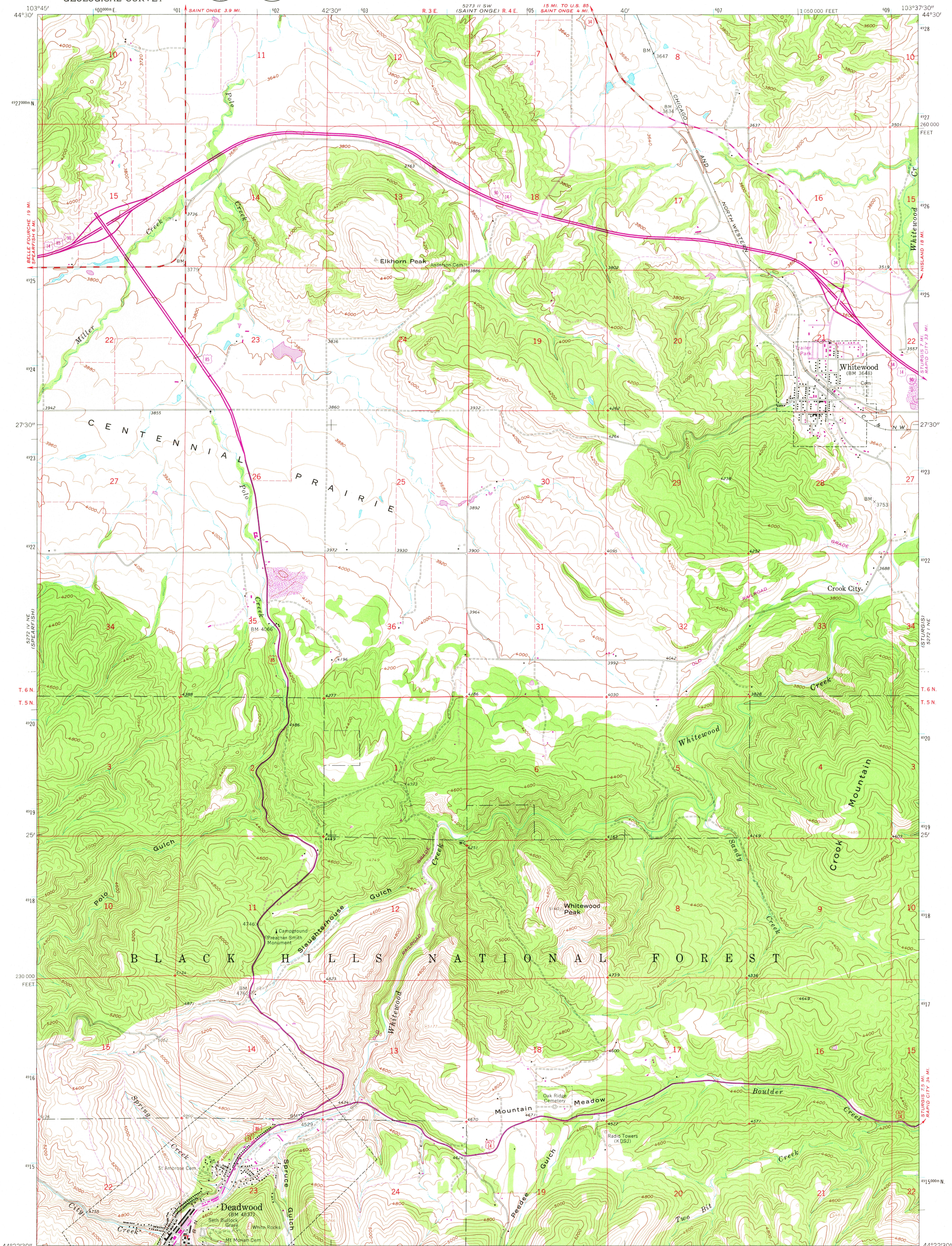

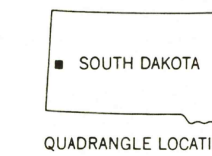
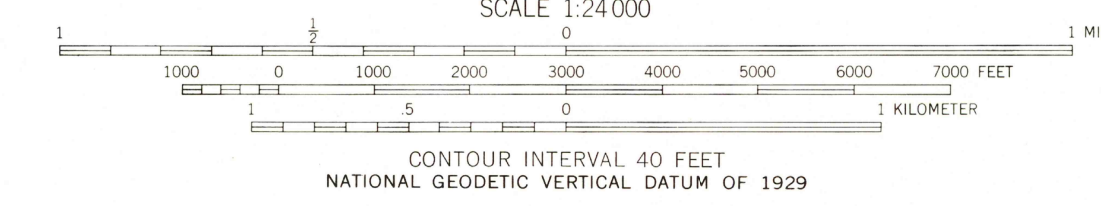
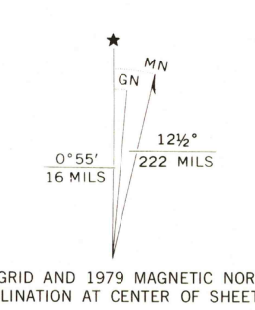
10,000-foot grid based on South Dakota coordinate system, north zone
