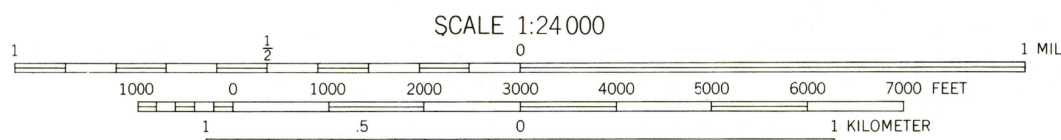
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue

UTM GRID AND 1950 MAGNETIC NORTH DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET

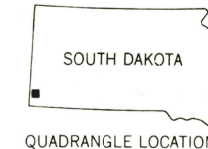
