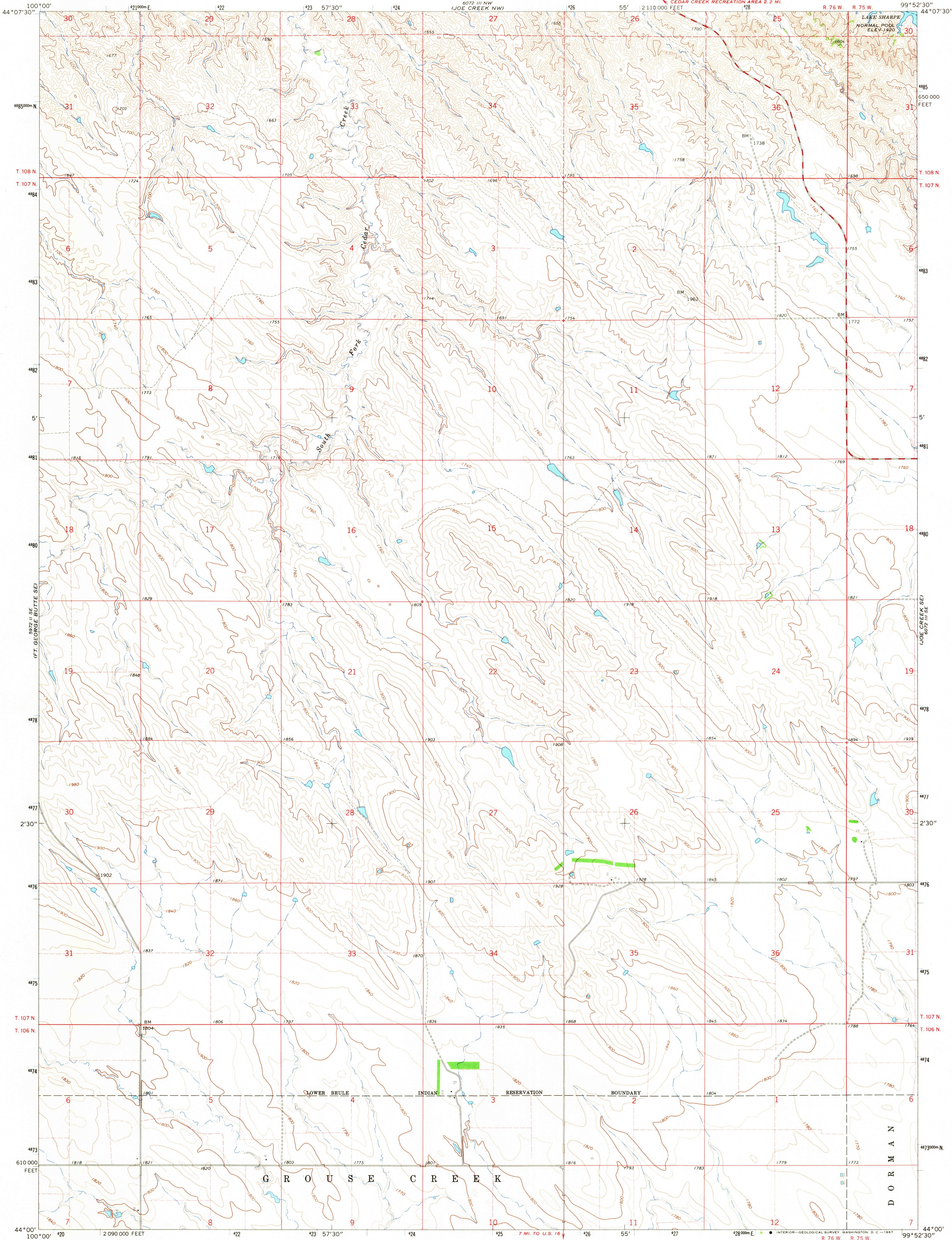

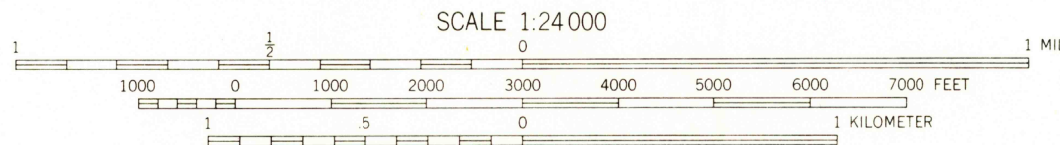
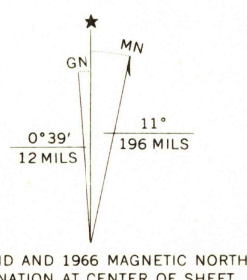

controlled inundation to 1423 feet

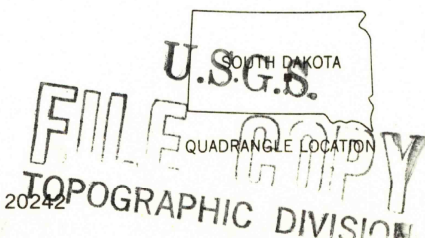
