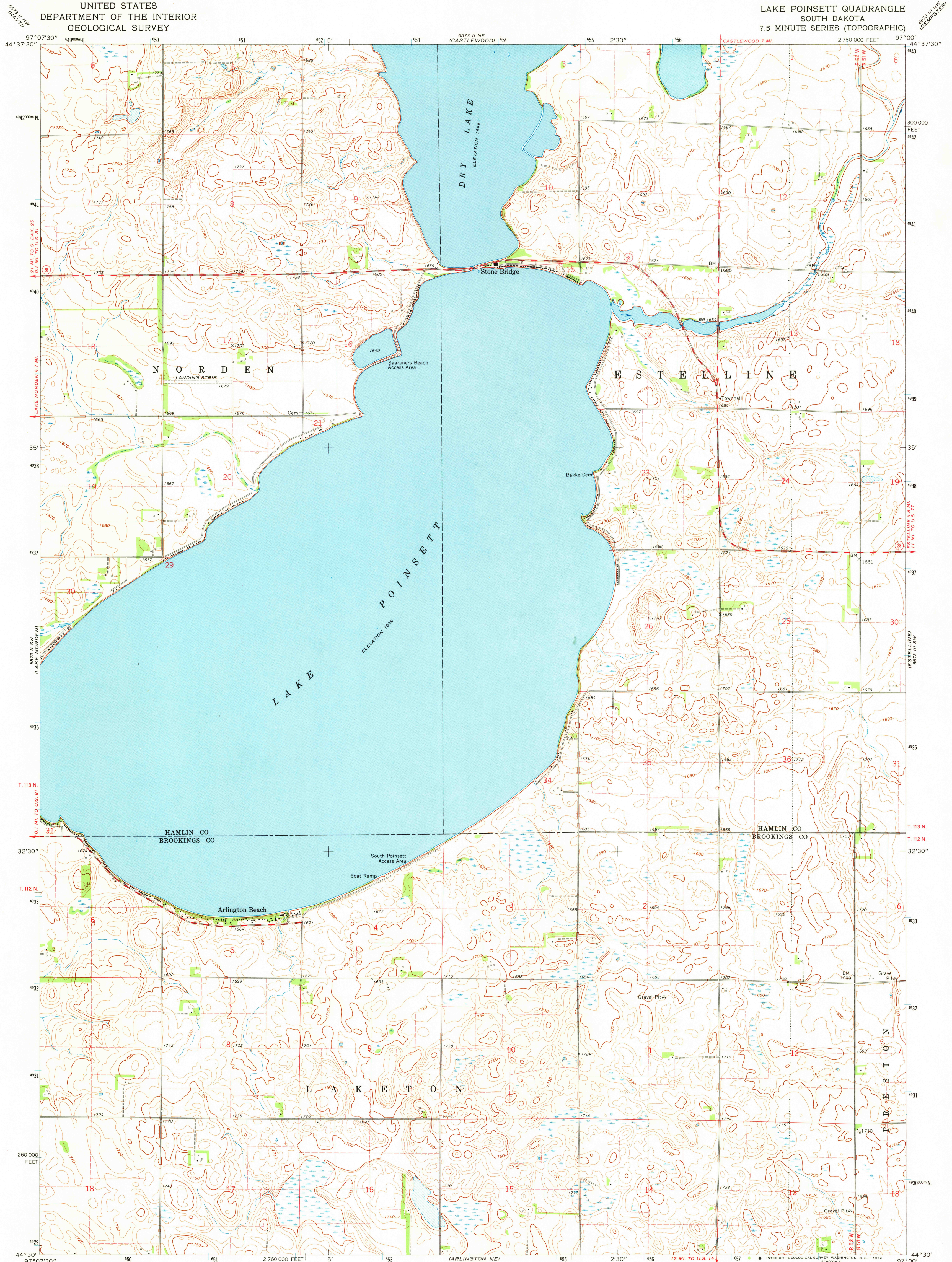
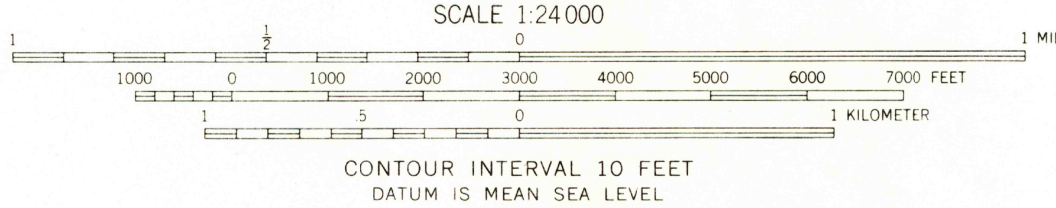

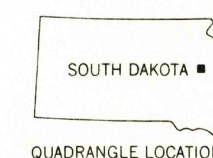
LAKE POINSETT QUADRANGLE
