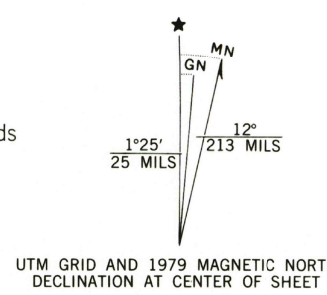

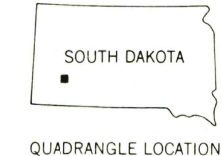
RED SHIRT QUADRANGLE
