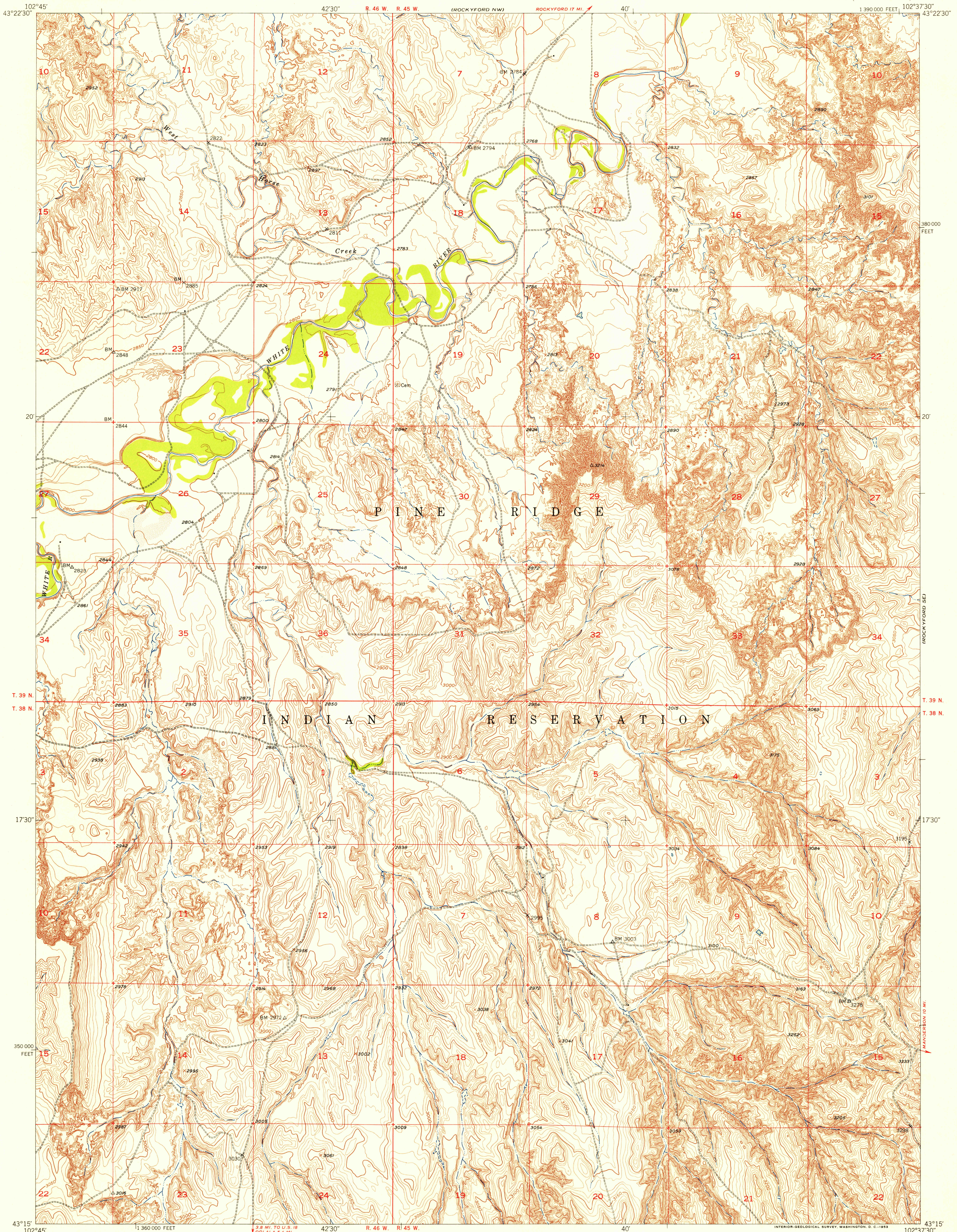


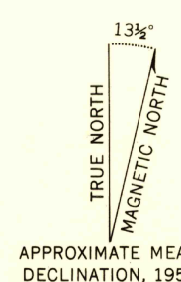

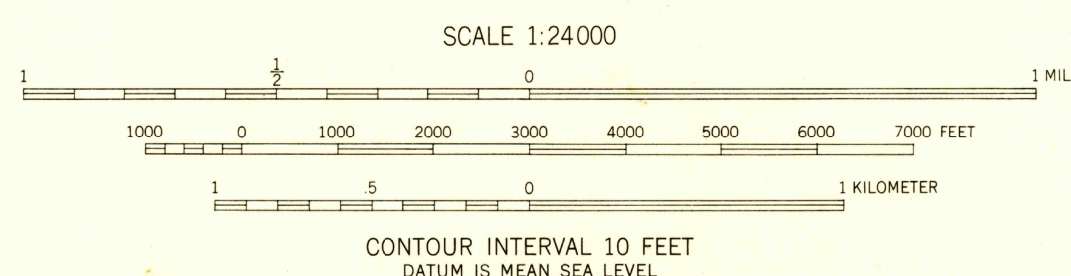

south zone

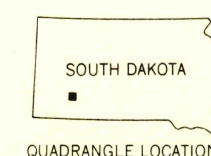


APPROXIMATE MEAN
