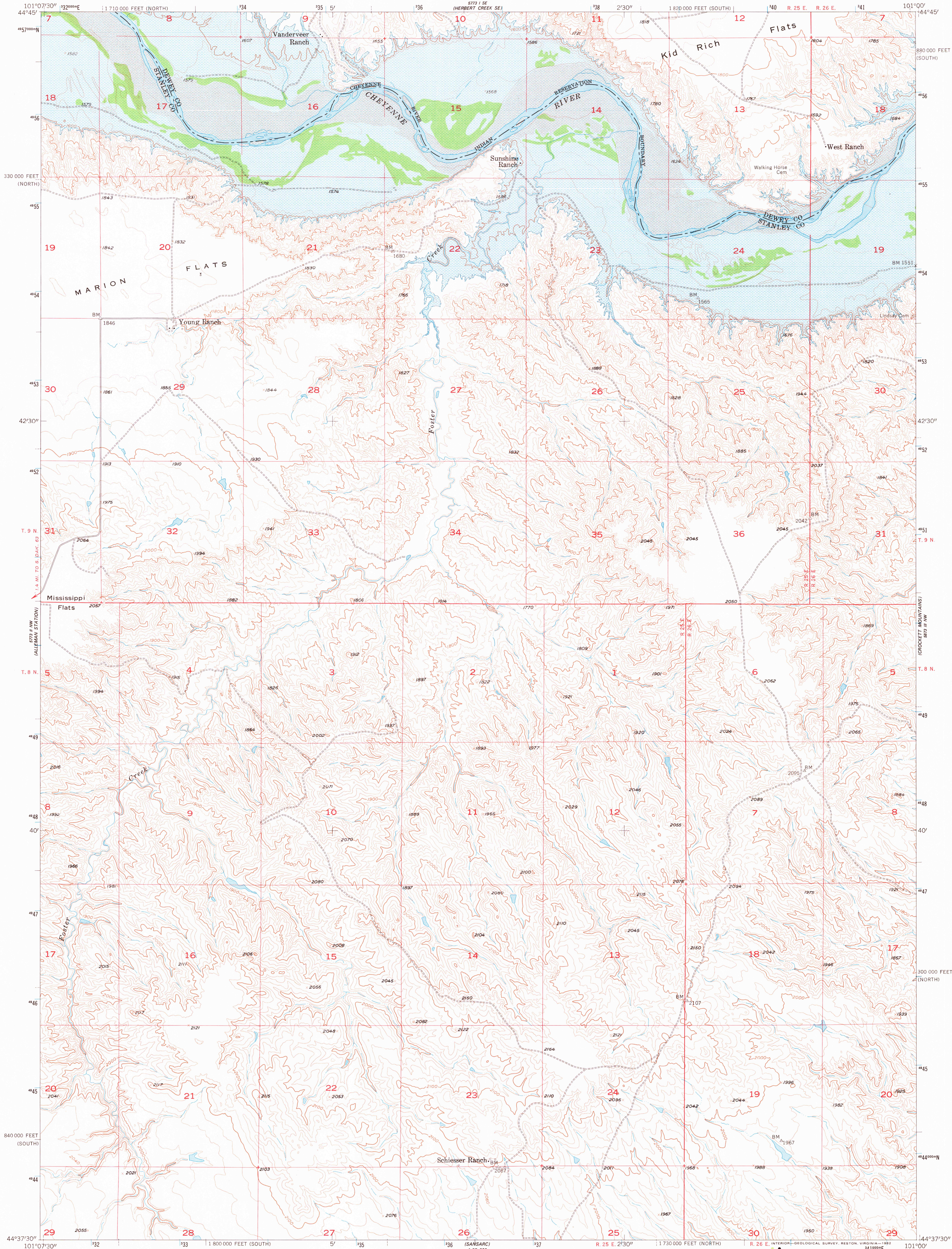

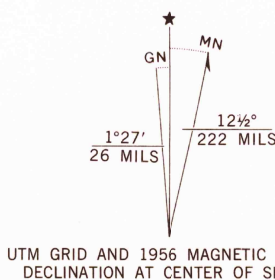

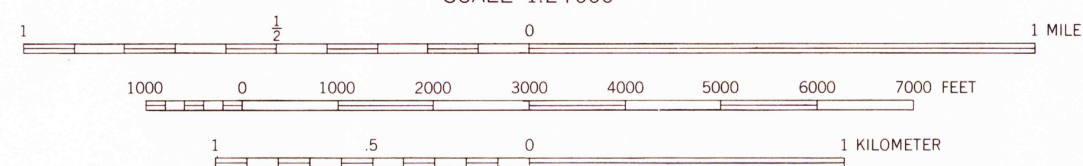
Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum

Oahe Reservoir. Elevation flood control pool 1617

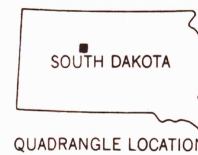
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
