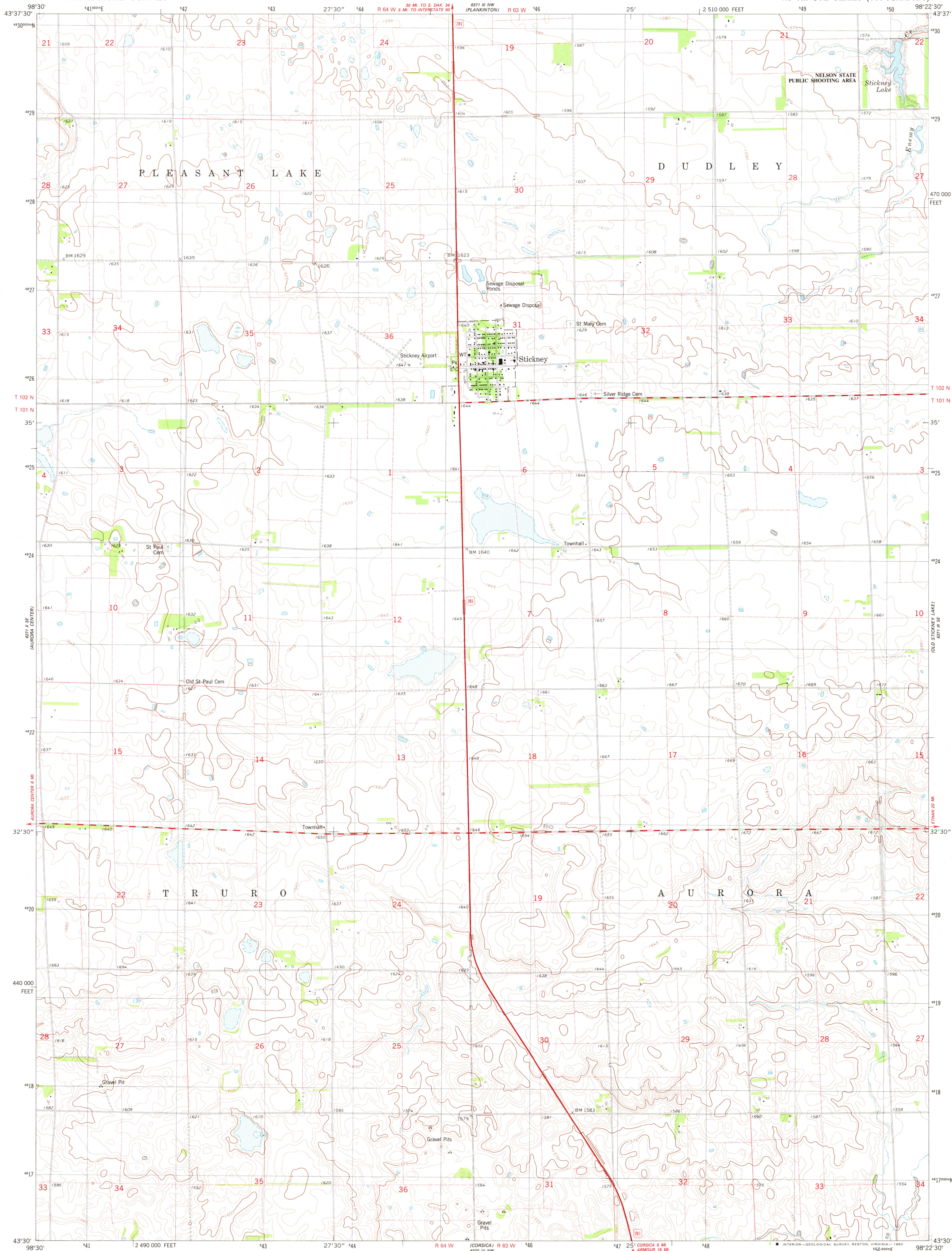

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: South Dakota coordinate system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic)

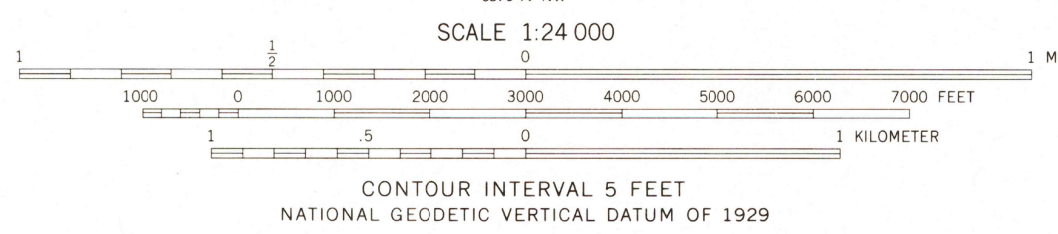
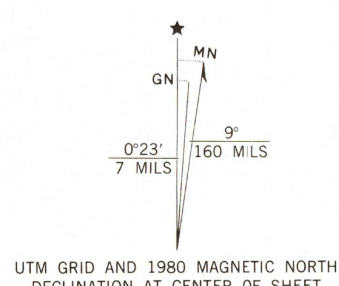
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 14
