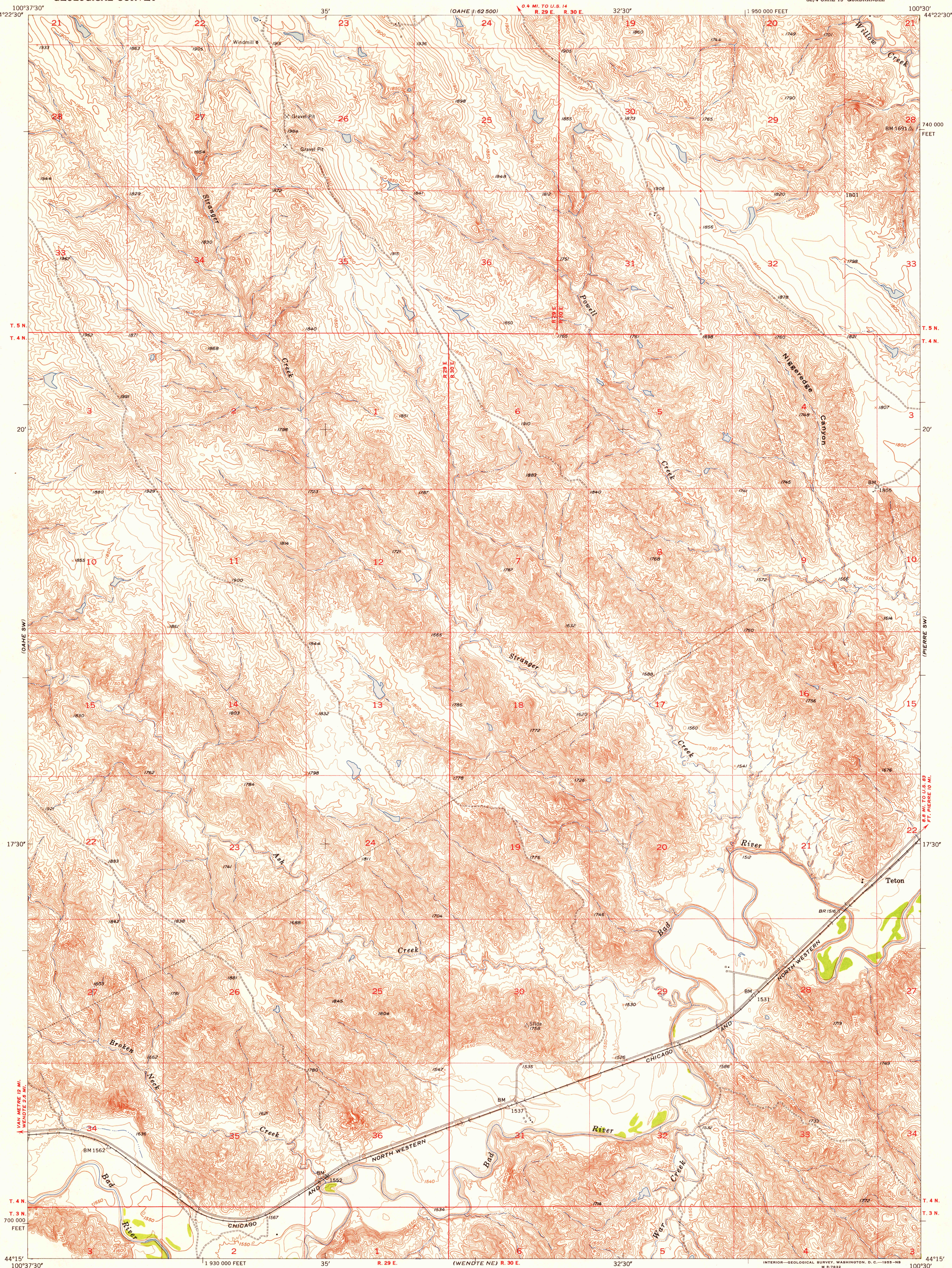

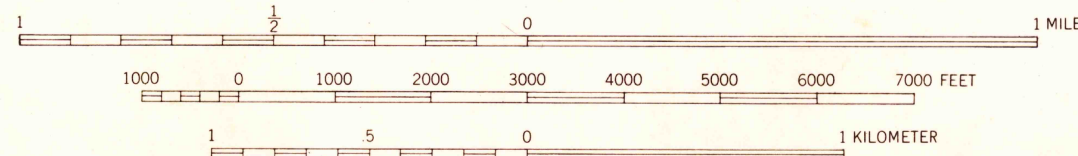

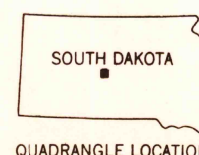
APPROXIMATE MEAN
