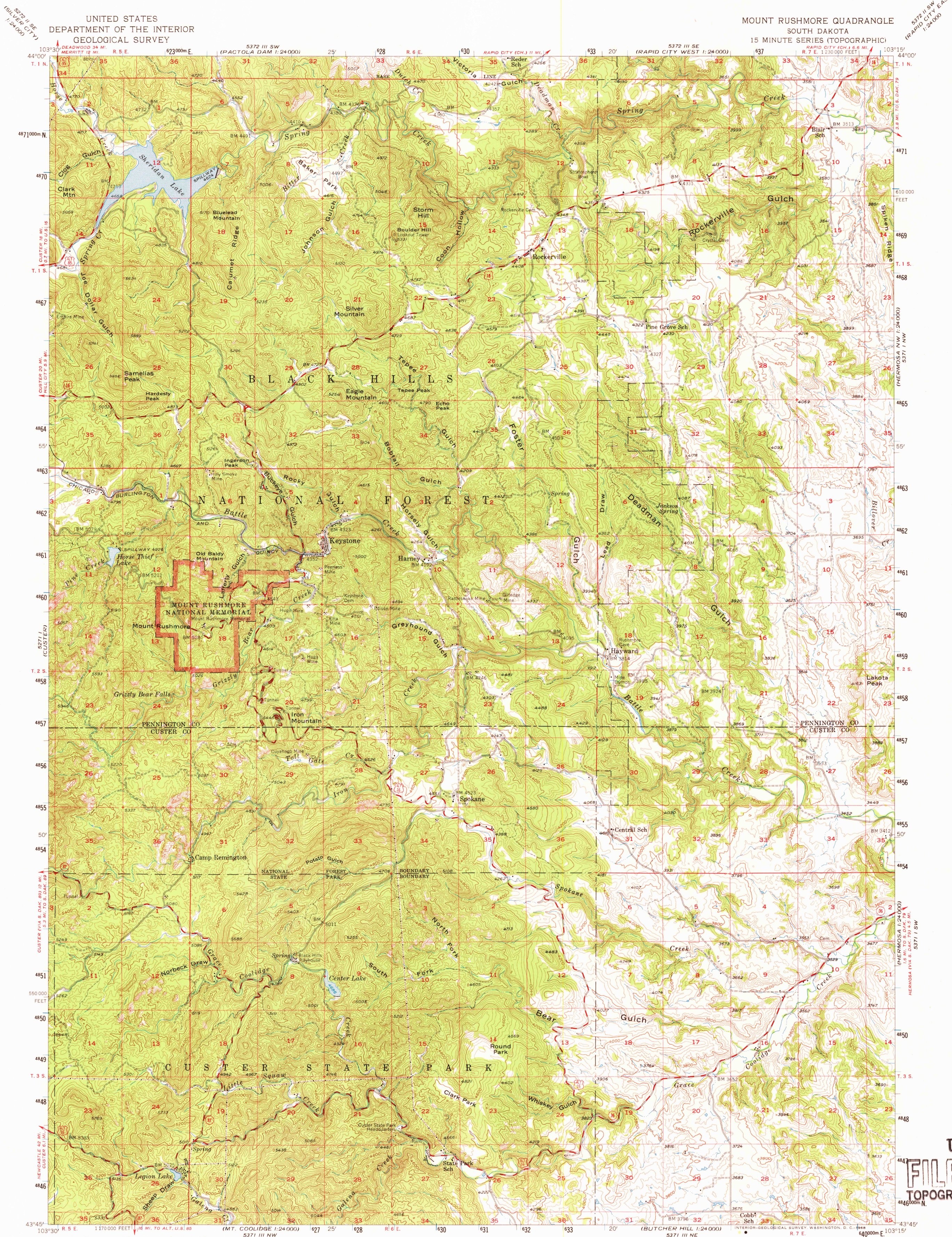


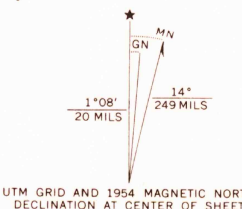

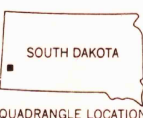
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 100,000-foot grid based on South Dakota coordinate system, south zone
