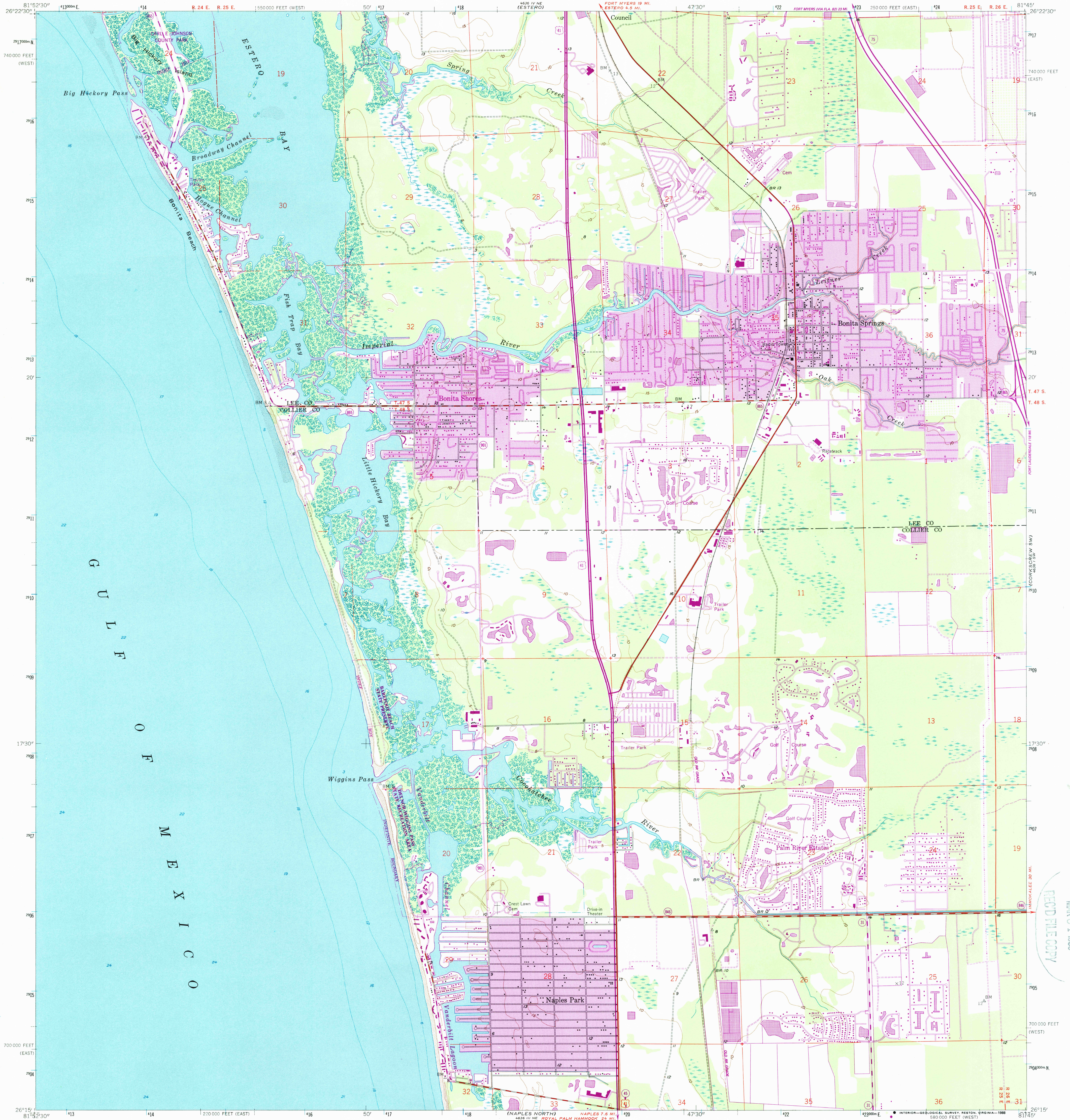

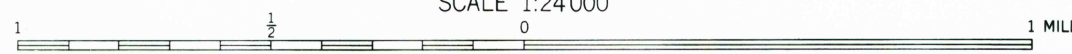
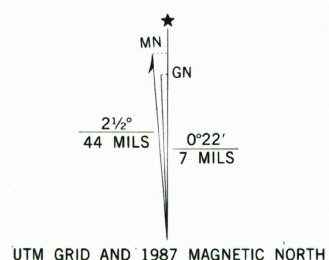

17 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
Purple tint indicates extension of urban areas
