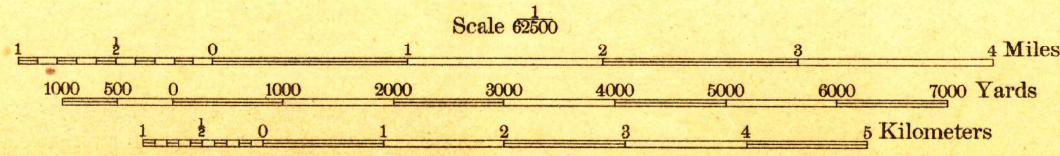
FLORIDA
