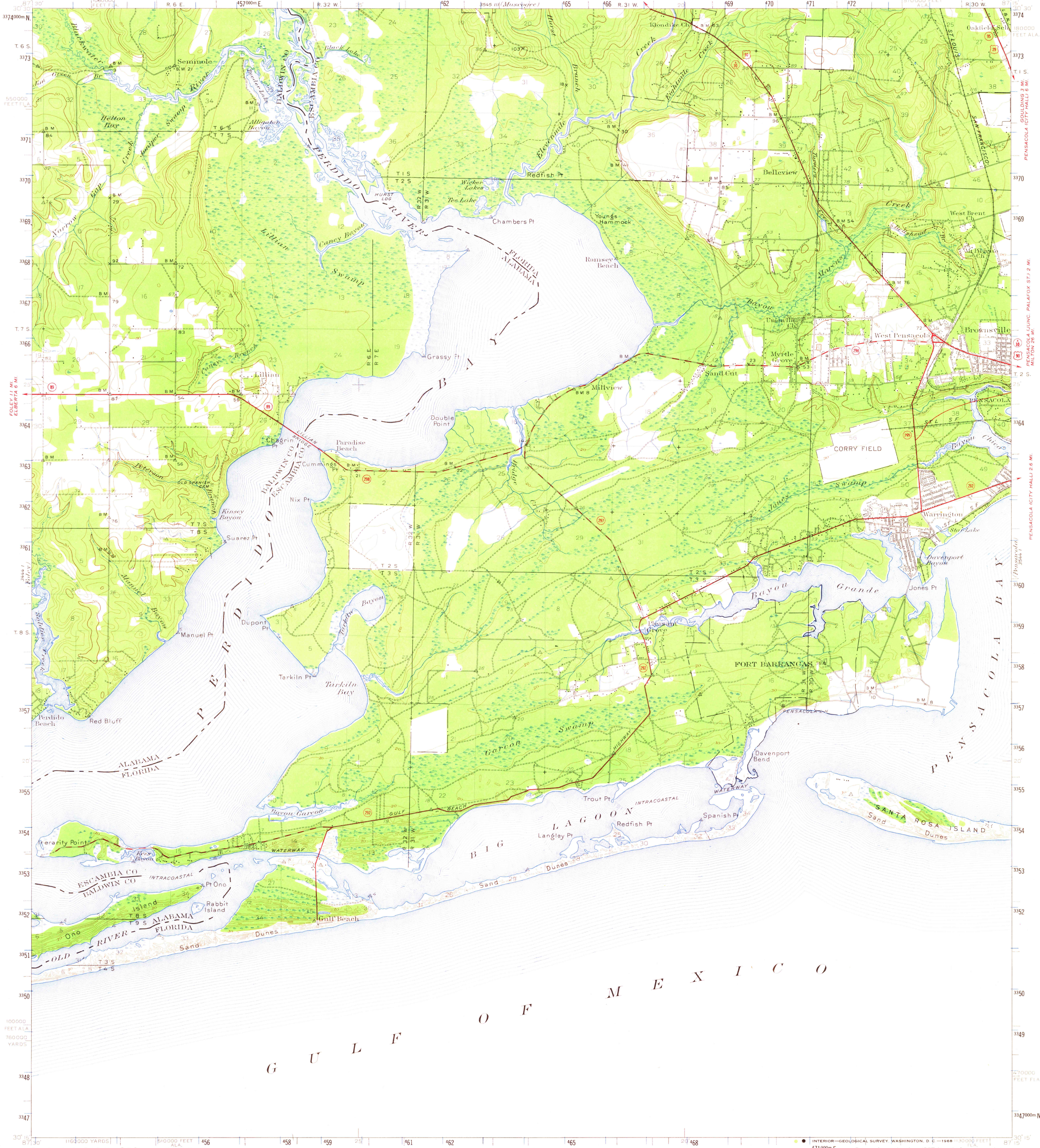

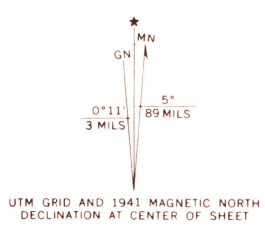
FLORIDA-ALABAMA
