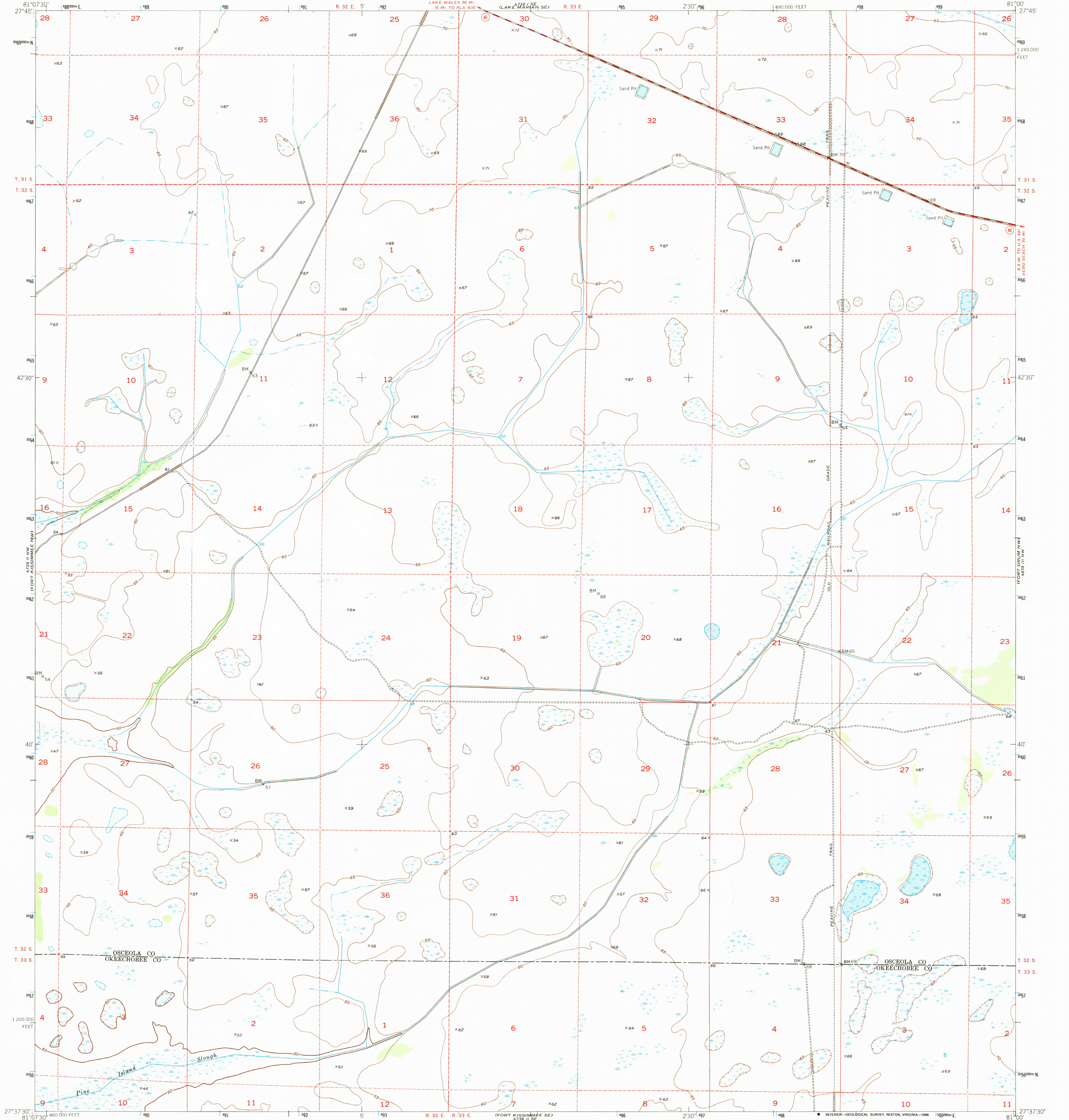

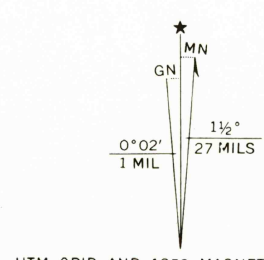

east zone

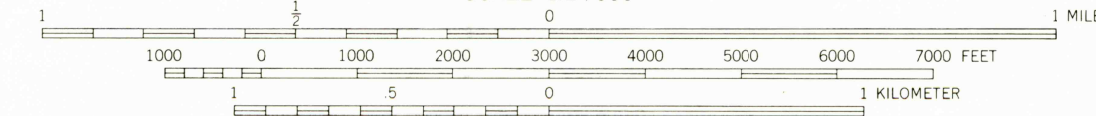
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
