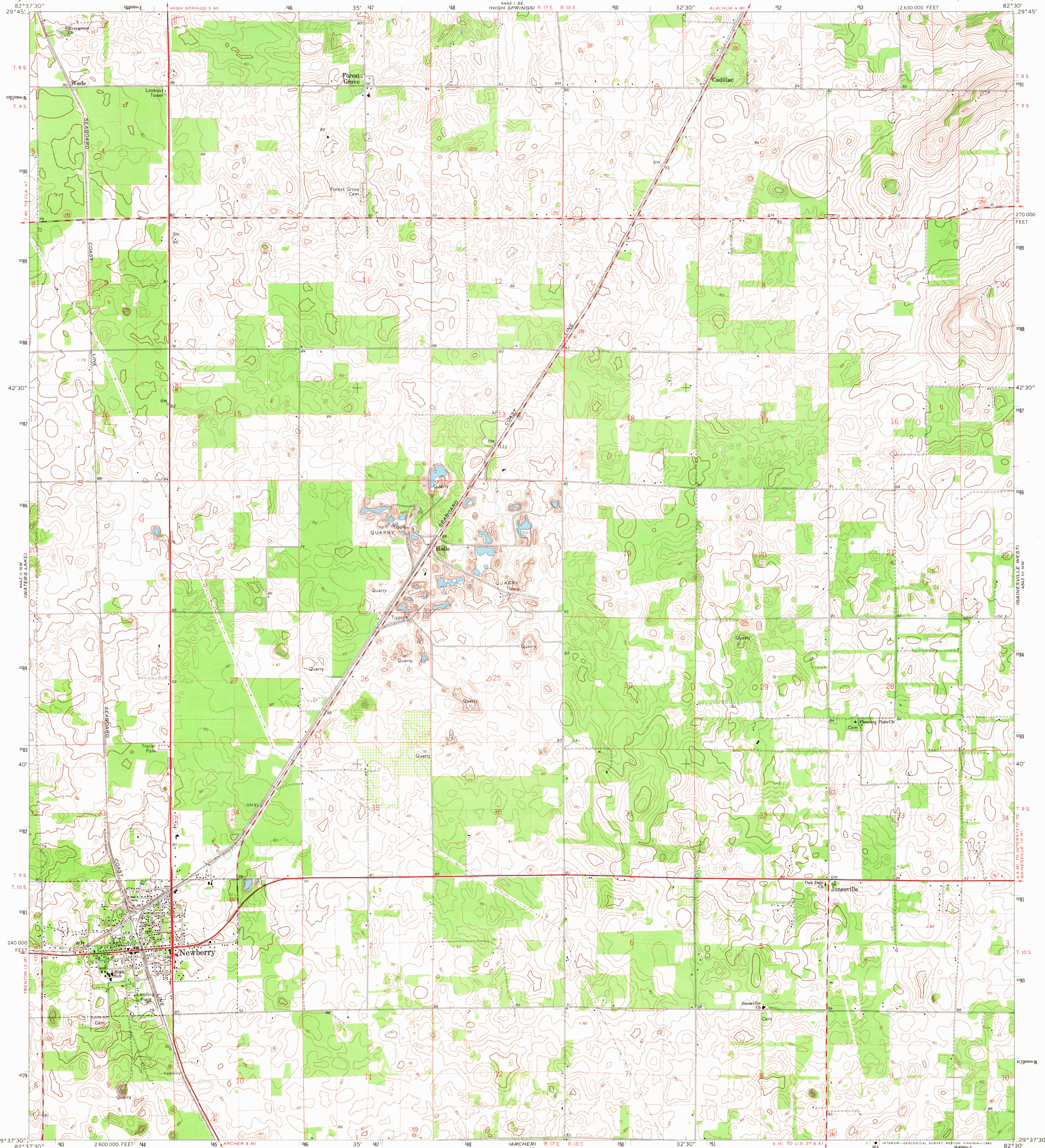

Florida coordinate system, north zone

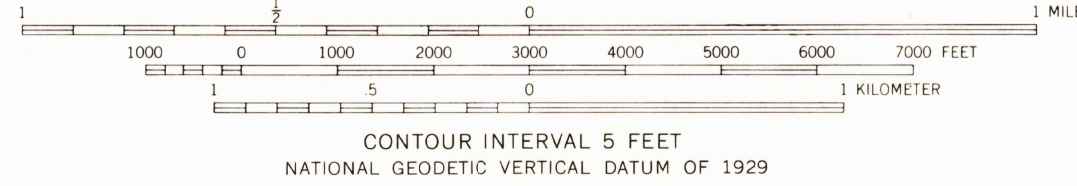
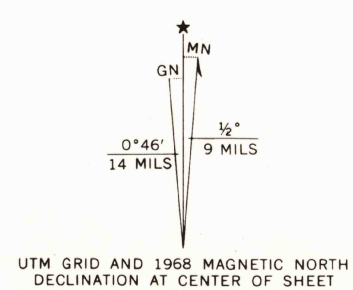
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks
