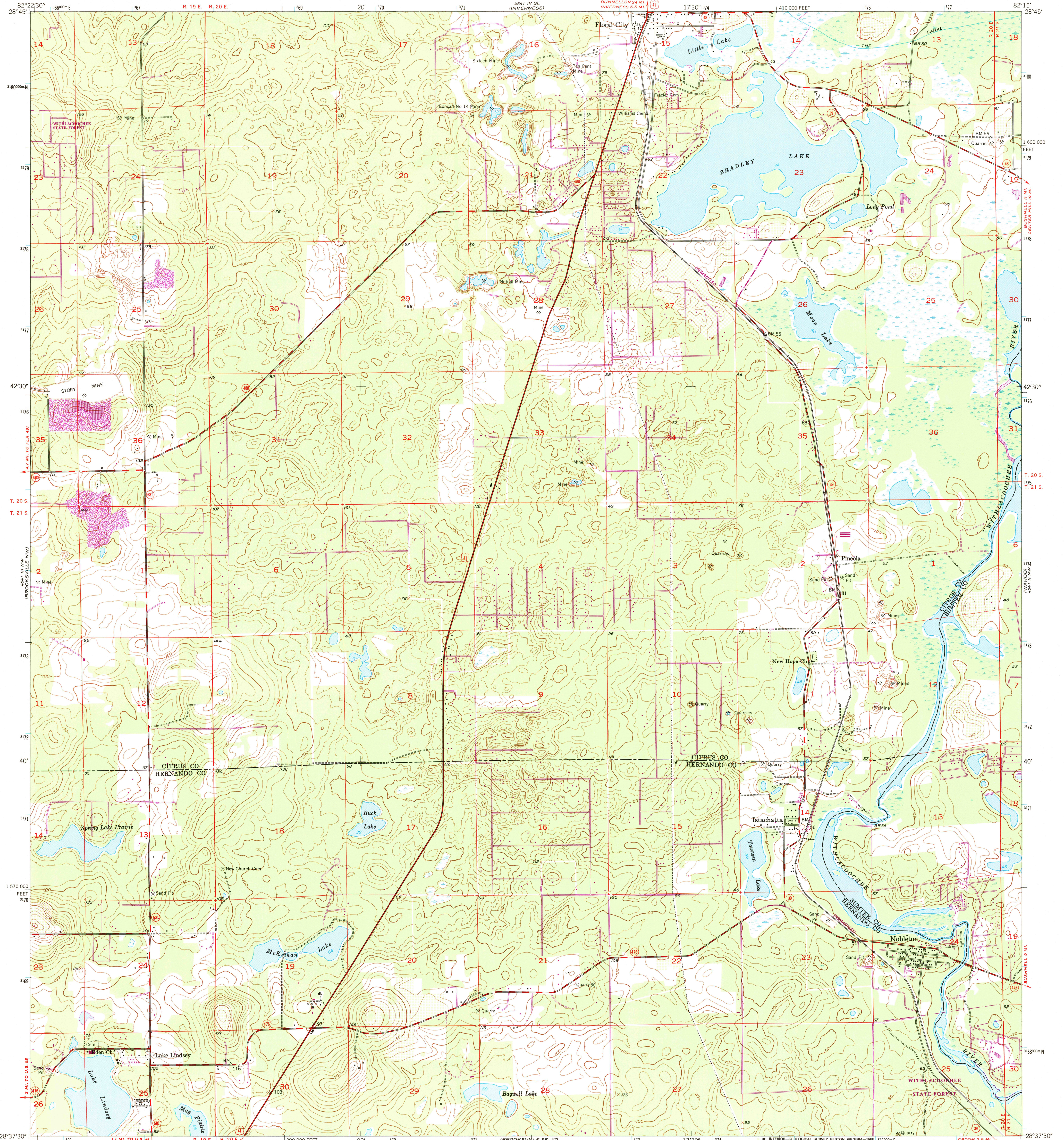

zone 17, shown in blue

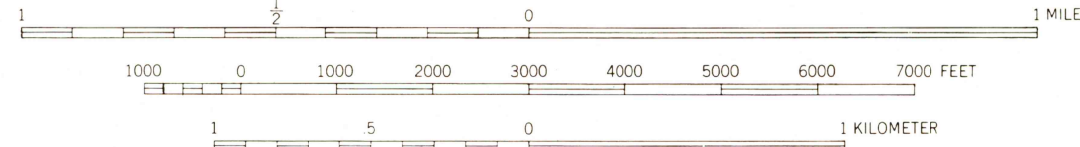
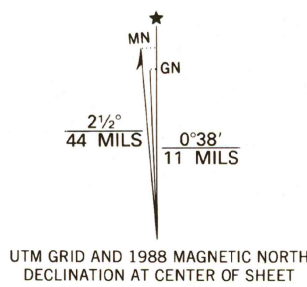
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983,

move the projection lines 27 meters south and

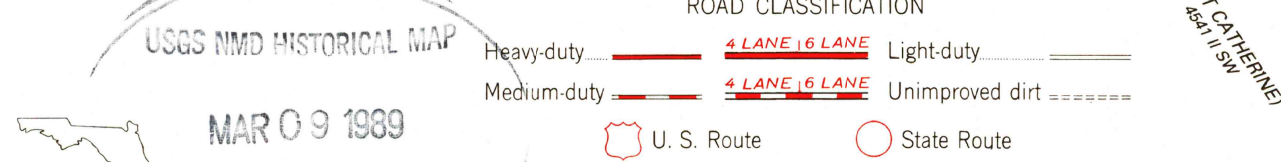
16 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
