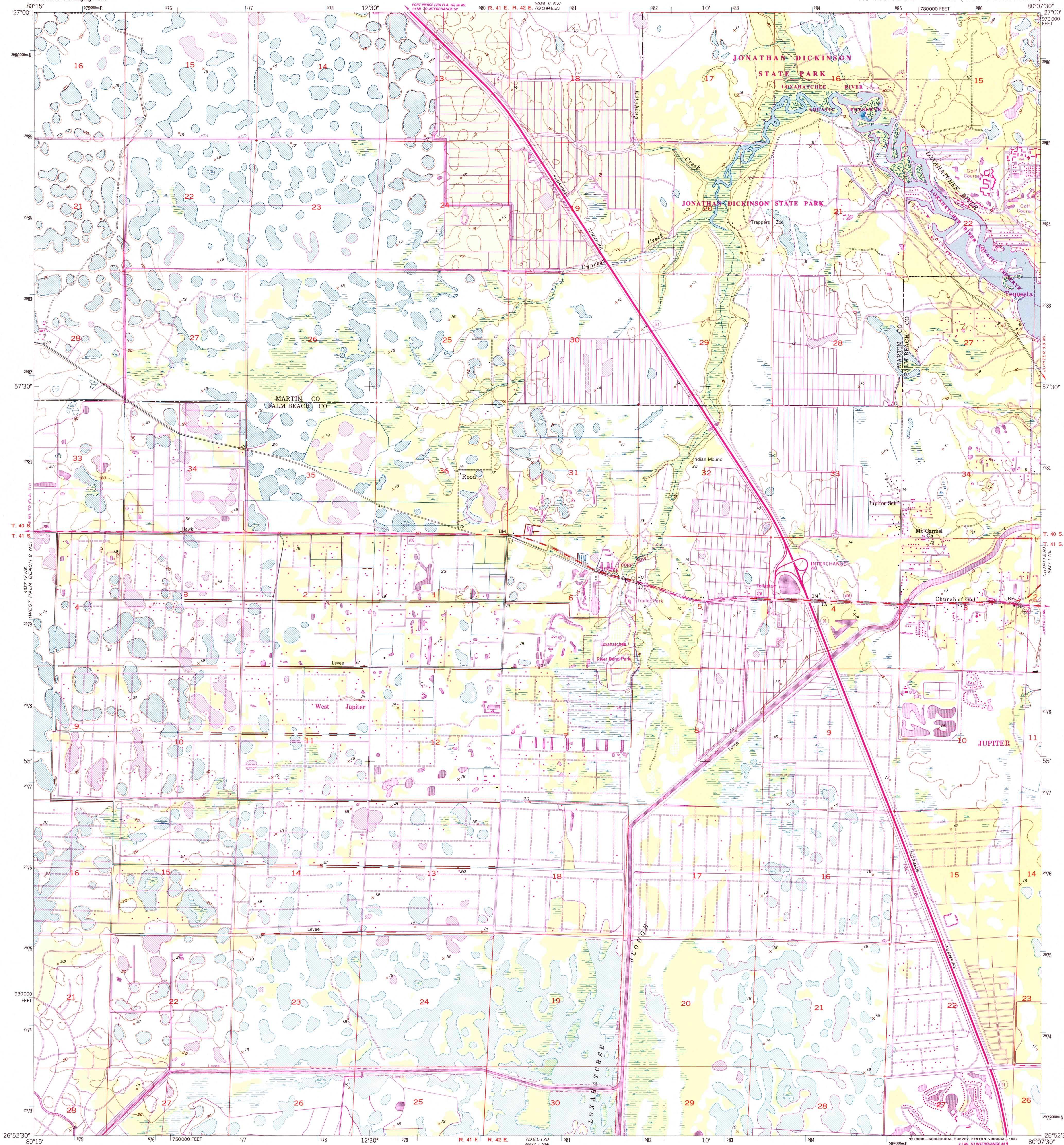

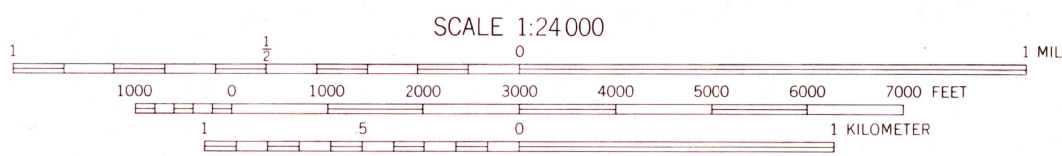
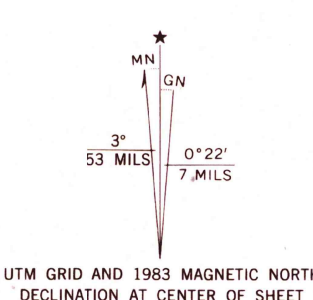

and 22 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
