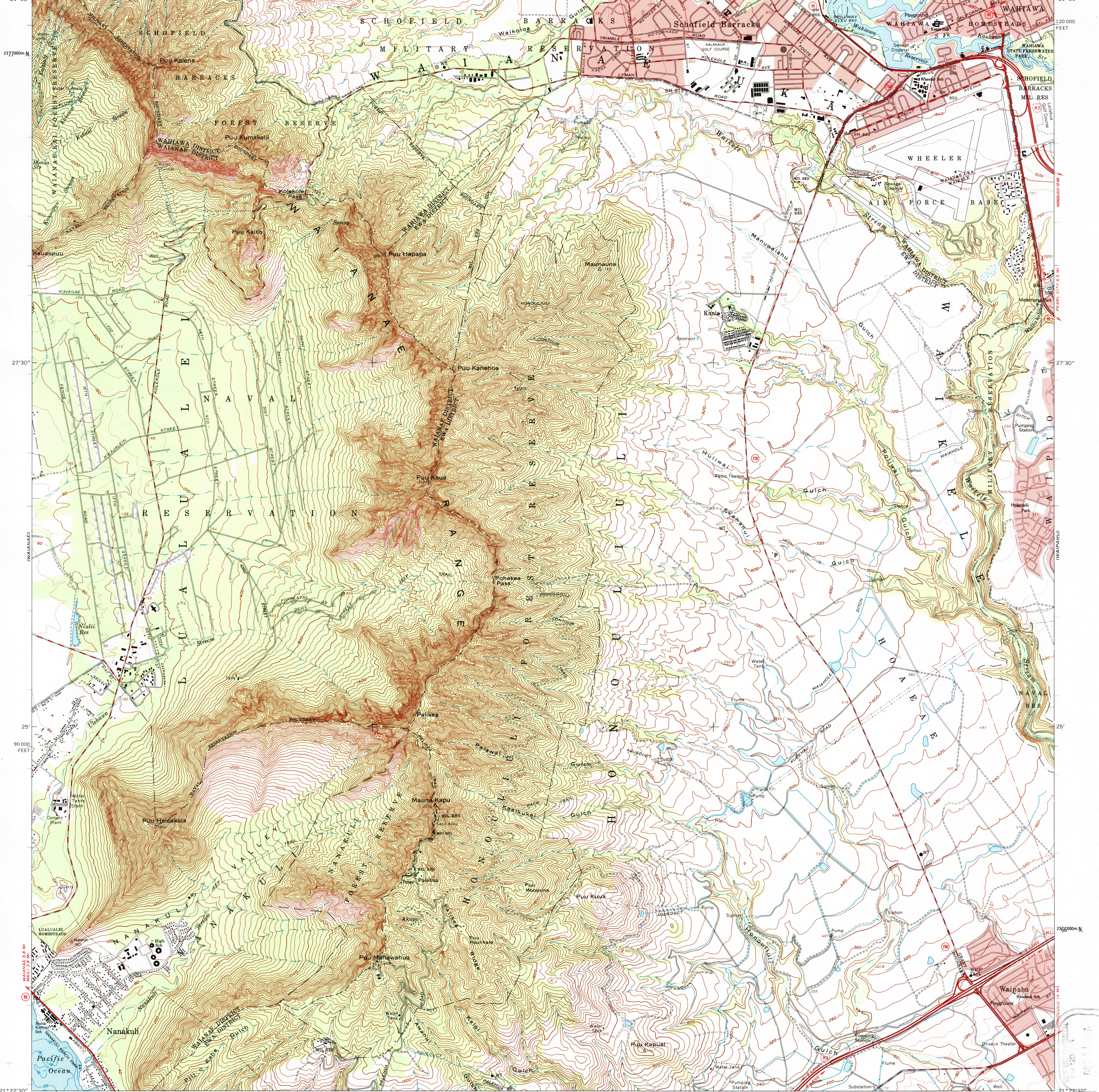

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection alines 354 meters north and 284 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
