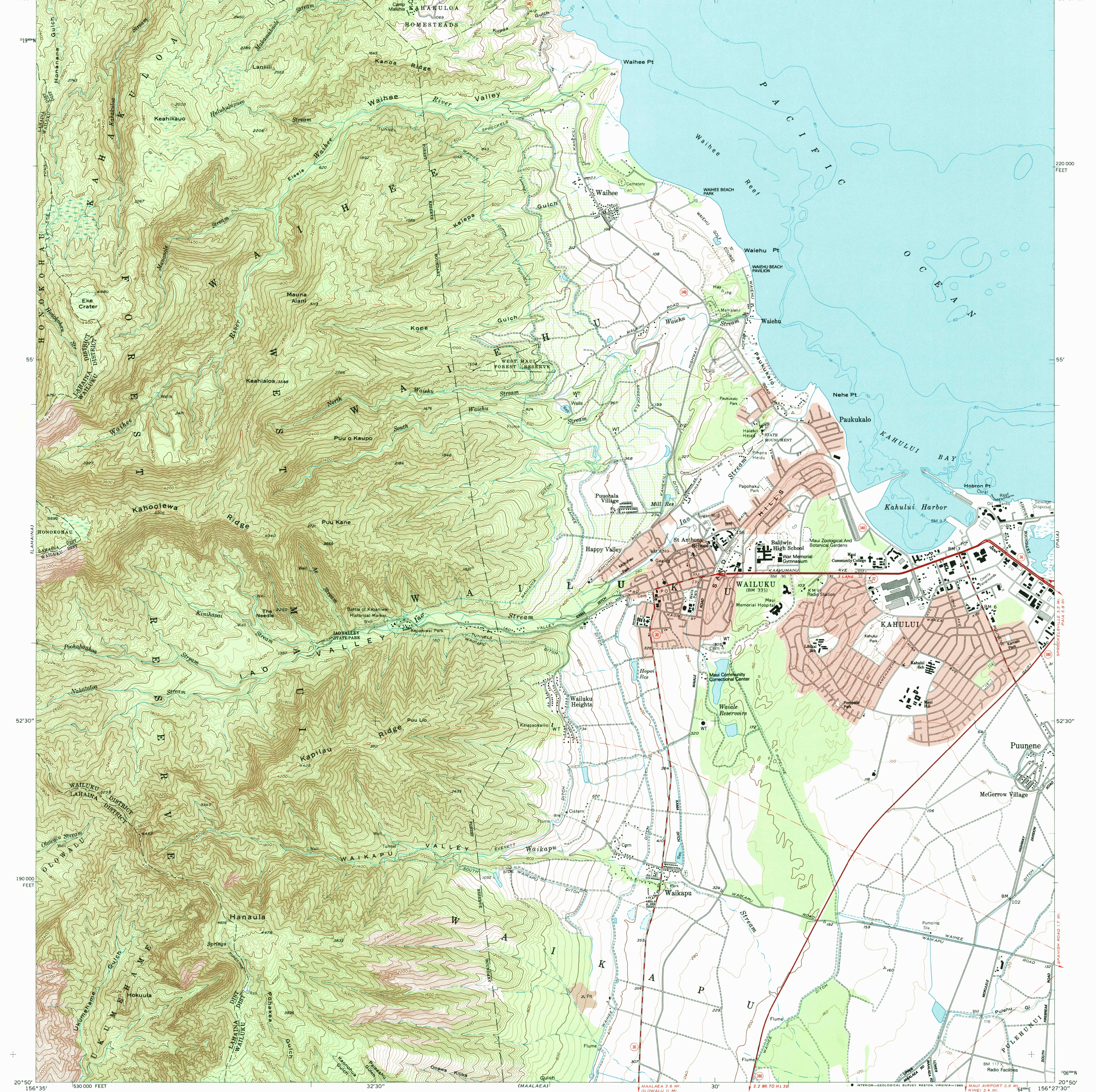

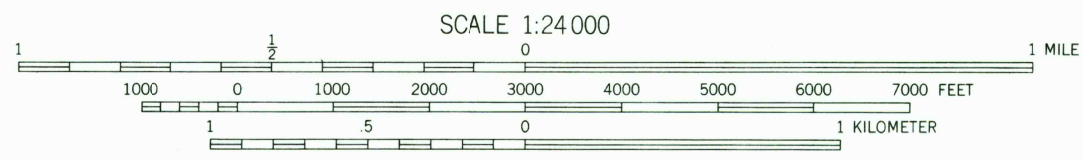

Old Hawaiian Datum 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 4, shown in blue. International spheroid. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 357 meters north and 291 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
