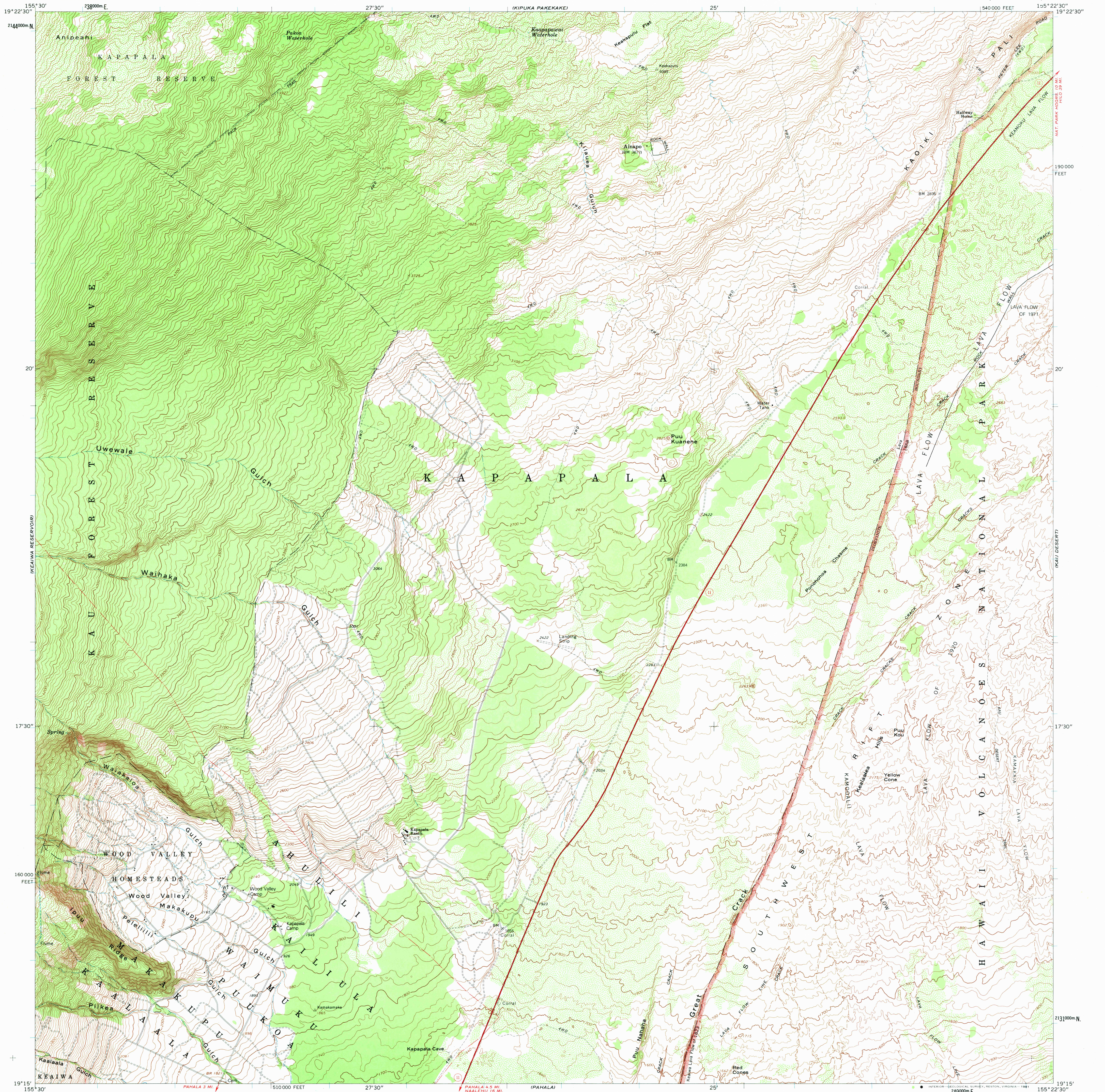

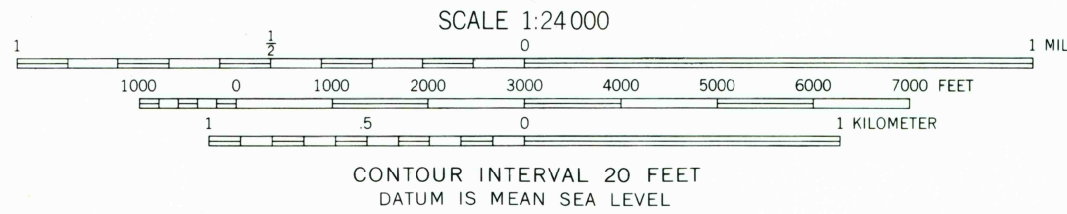
Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Hawaii coordinate system,

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

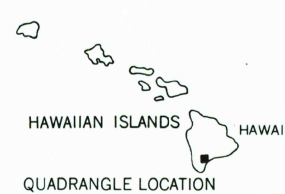
