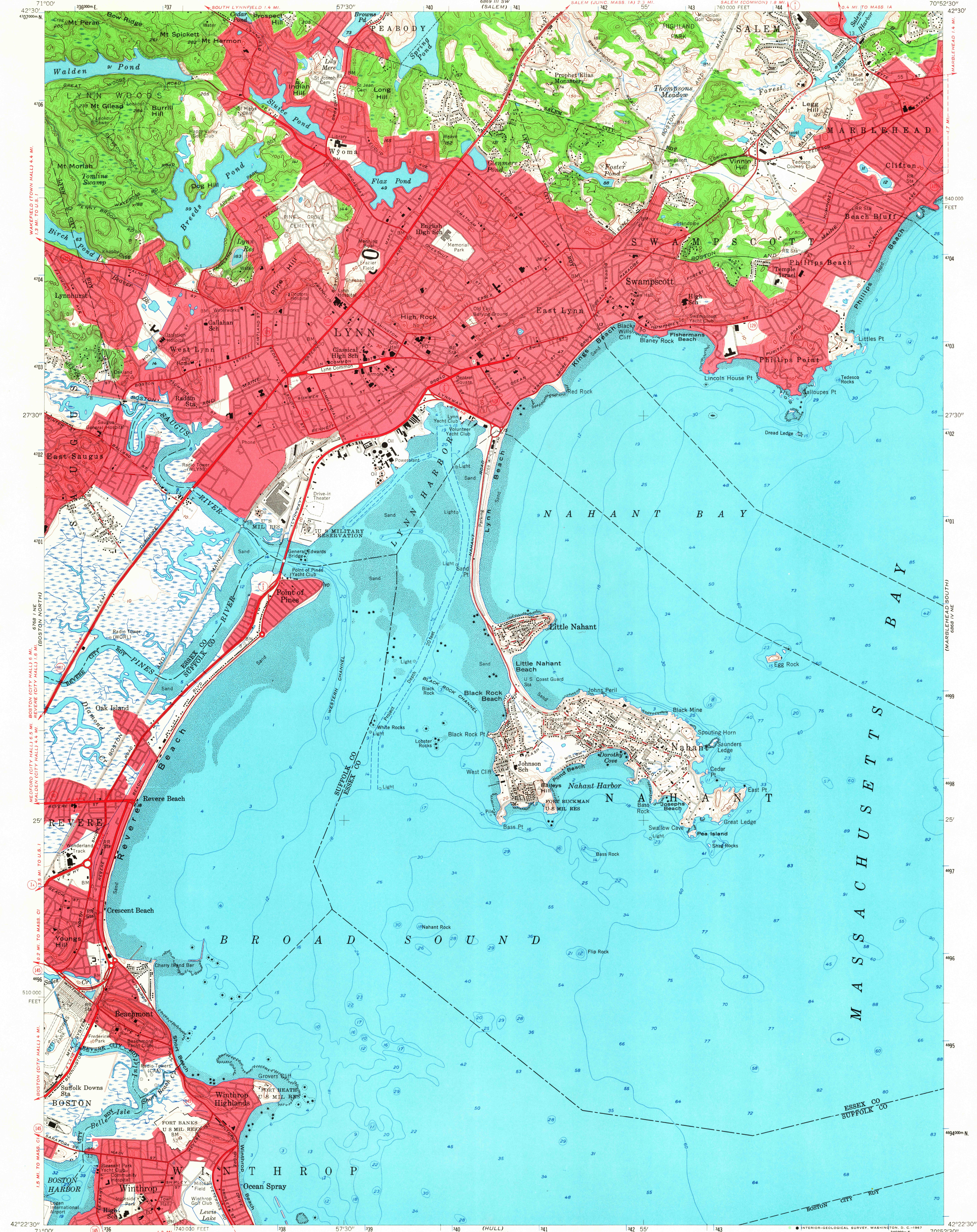

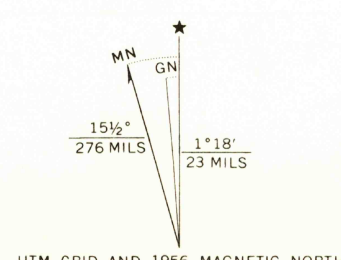

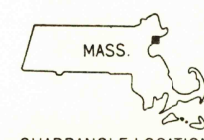
THE MEAN RANGE OF TIDE AT LYNN HARBOR IS APPROXIMATELY 9.2 FEET
