

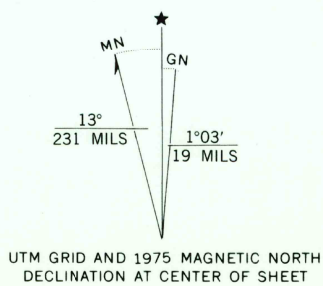

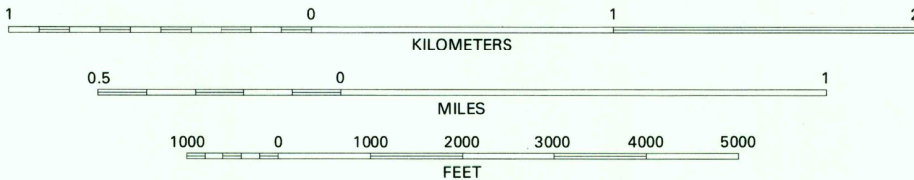
Orthophotograph prepared from 1:80,000-scale aerial photograph taken October 28, 1975
