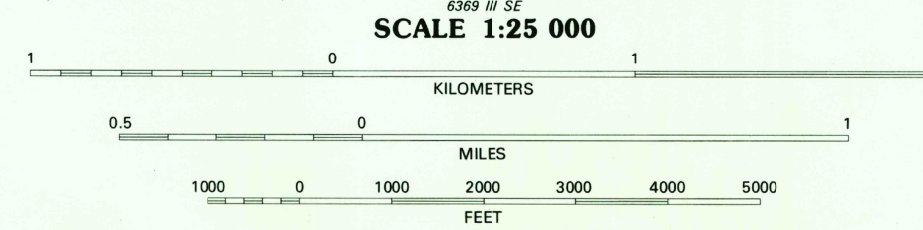
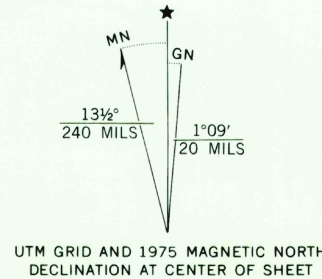
BERLIN QUADRANGLE
