ORANGE QUADRANGLE

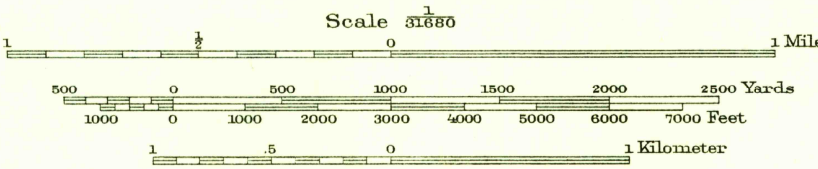
