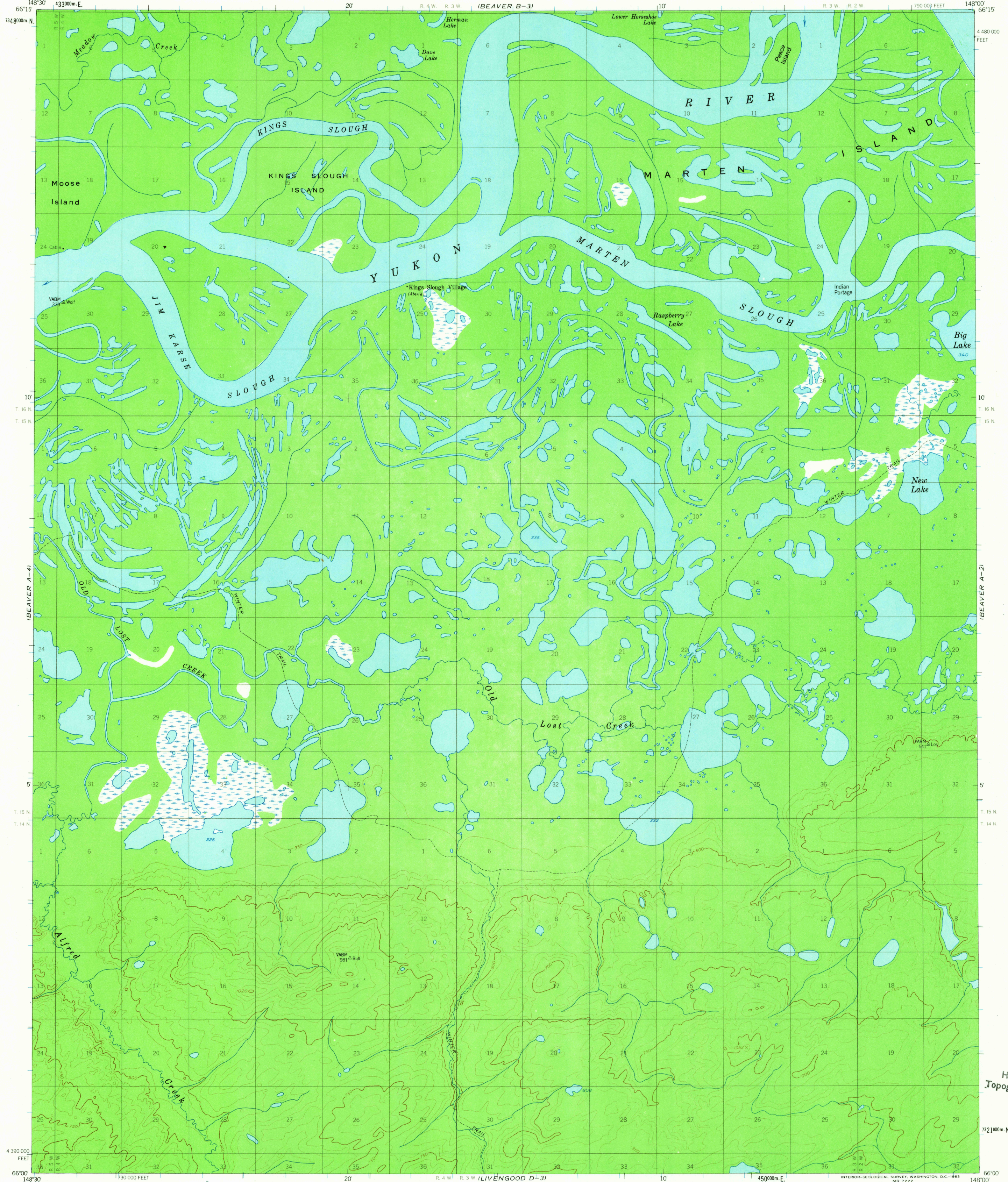

zone 6, shown in blue

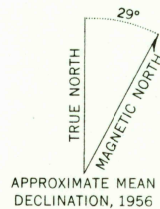
Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations

predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management

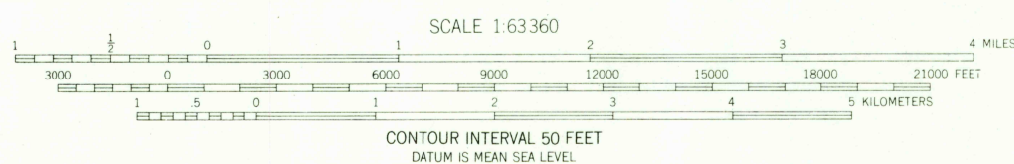
Folios F-3 and F-6, Fairbanks Meridian
