determined by the Bureau of Land Management

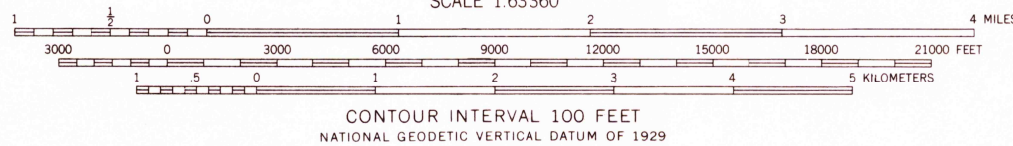
