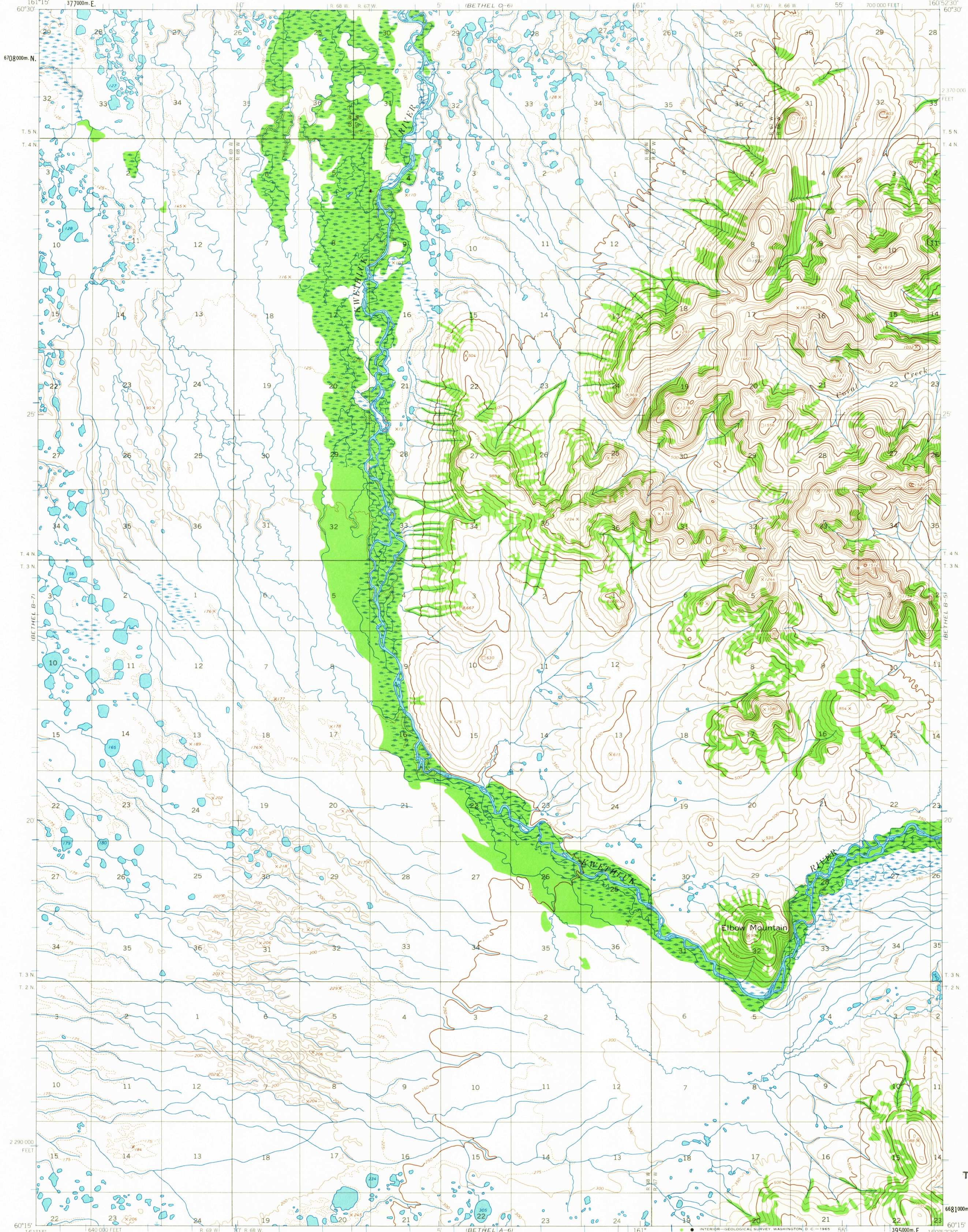

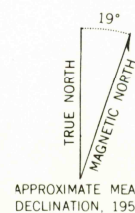
BETHEL (B-6) QUADRANGLE

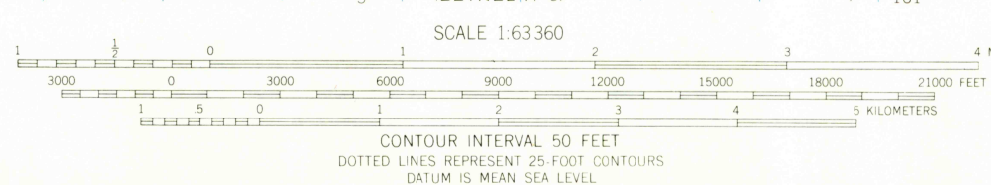
