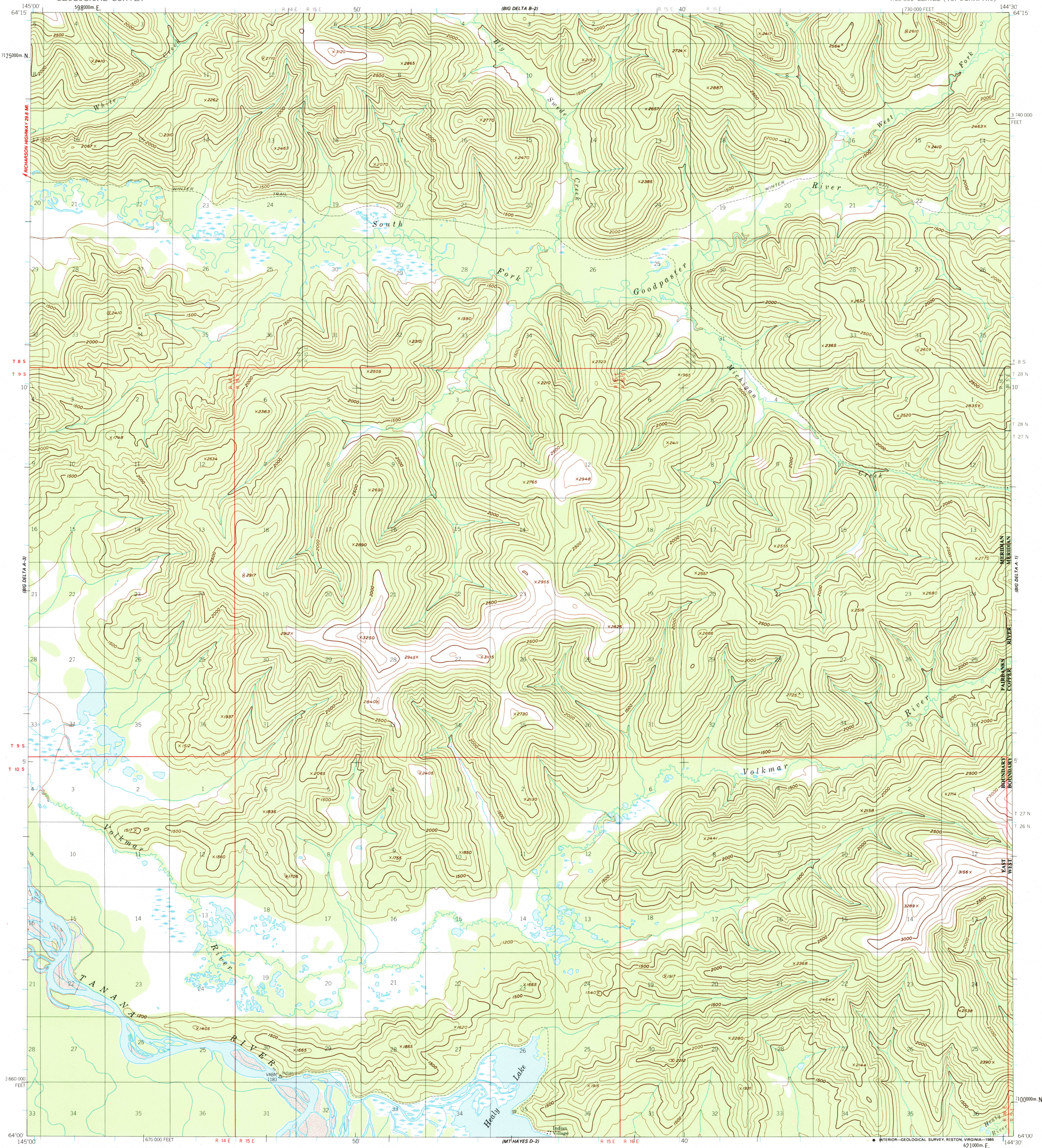

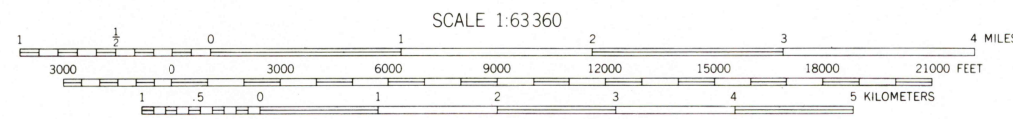
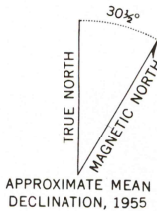
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
the projection lines 46 meters north and 114 meters east

predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management
Folios F-9, Fairbanks Meridian and CR-1, Copper River Meridian

Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
