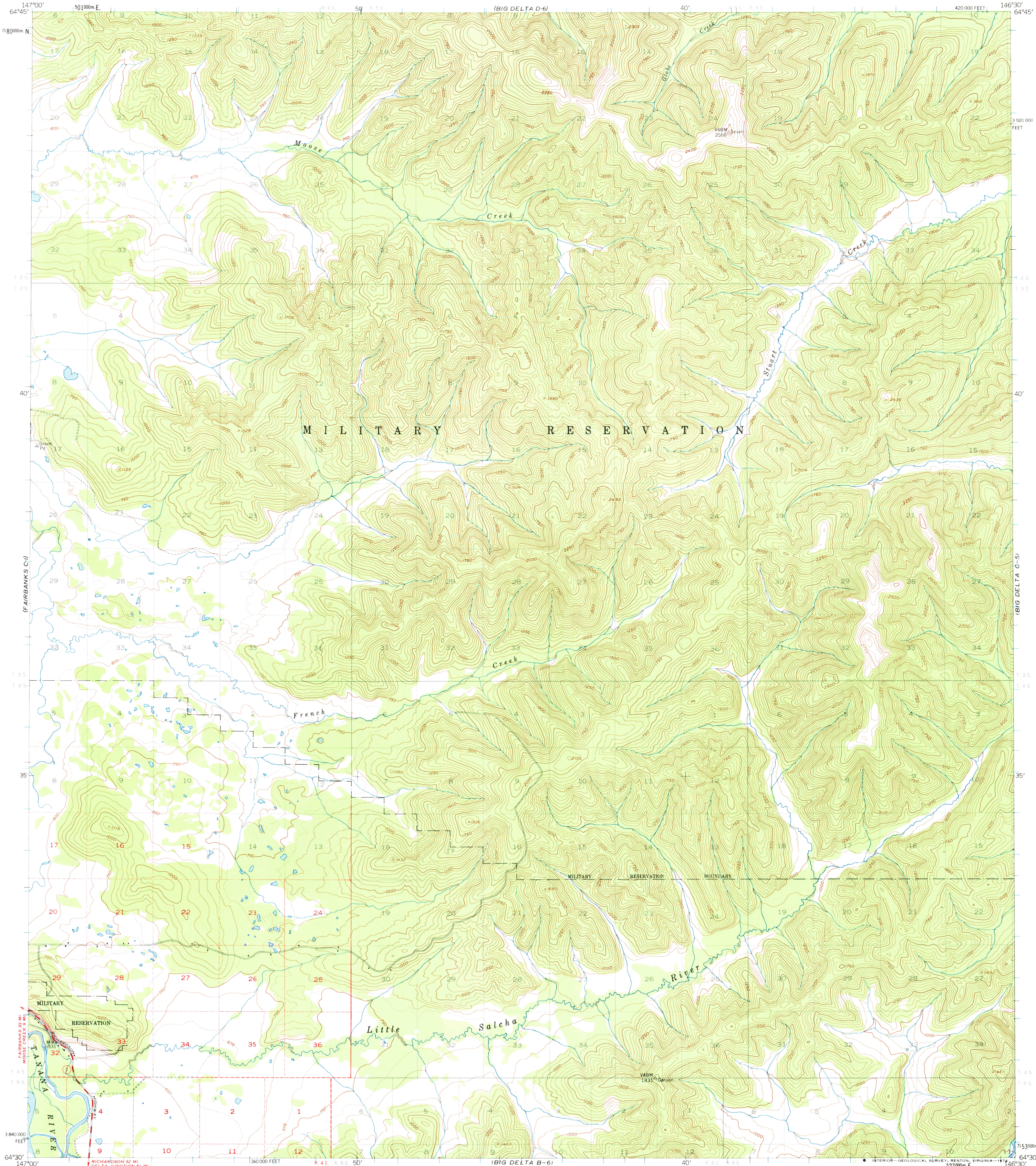

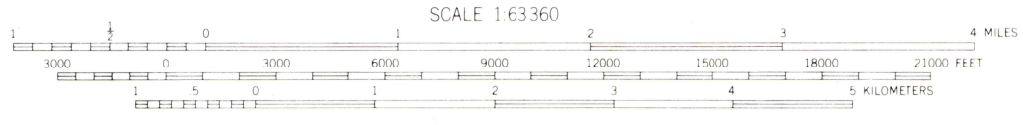
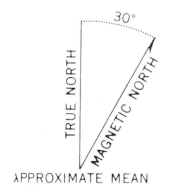
BIG DELTA (C-6) QUADRANGLE
