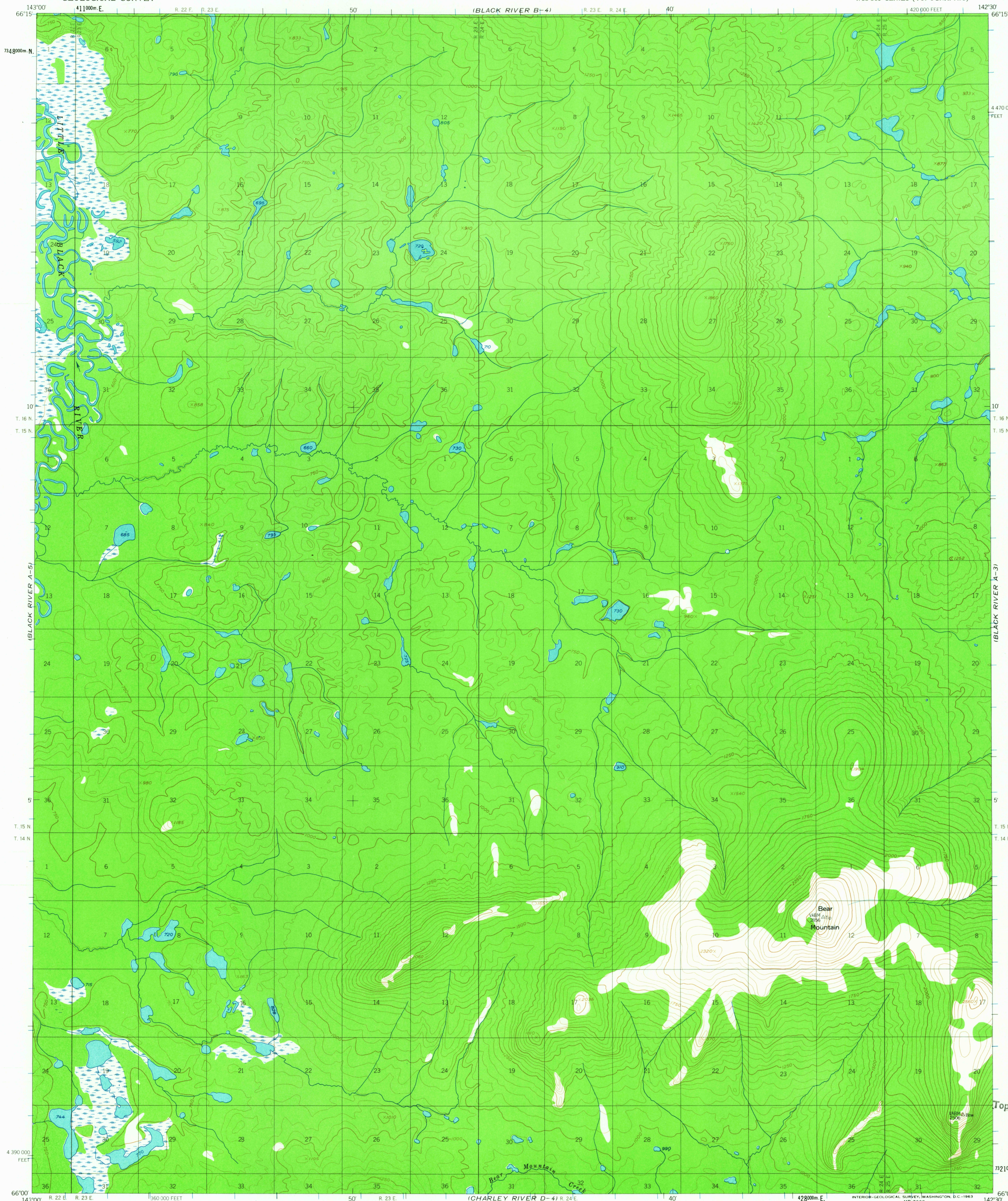

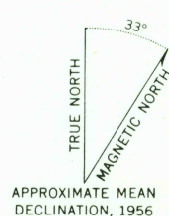

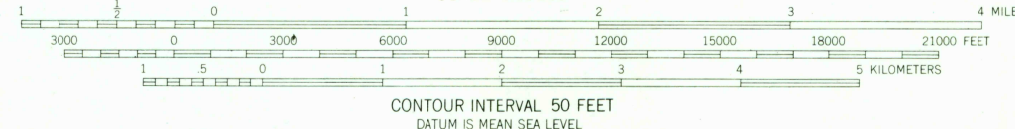

Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management. Folios F-1 and F-8, Fairbanks Meridian.

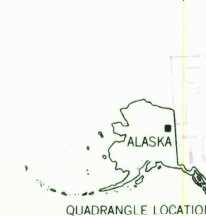
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs.
