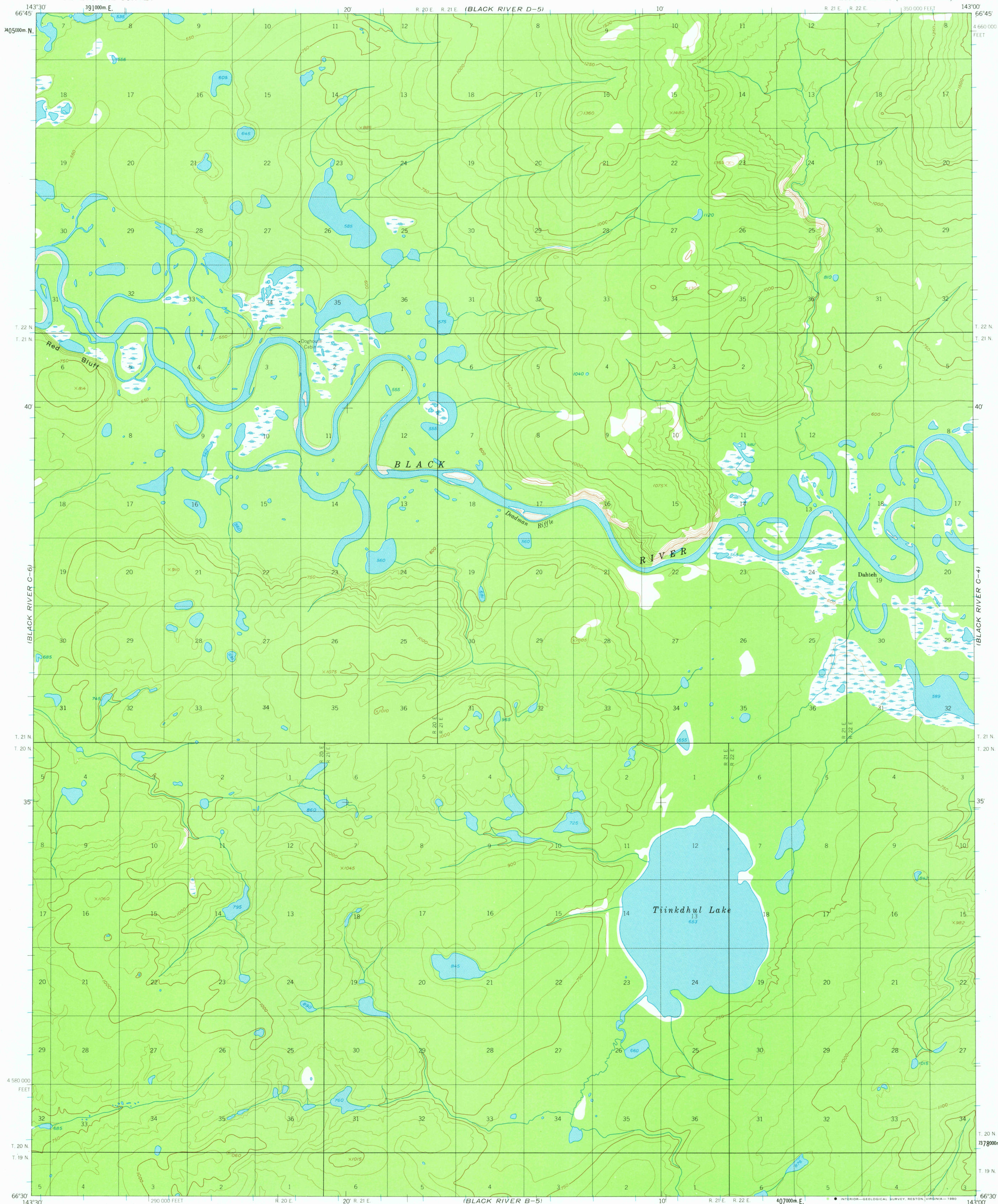
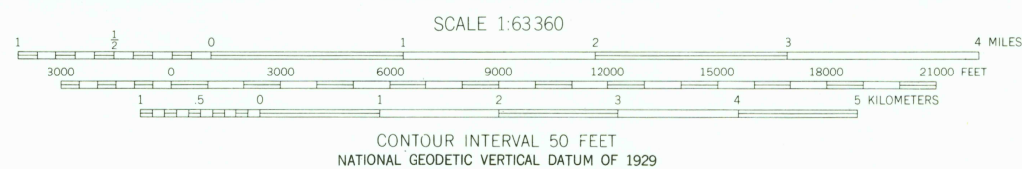
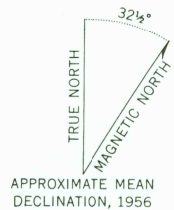

Folio F-1, Fairbanks Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs.
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
the projection lines 36 meters north and 112 meters east
