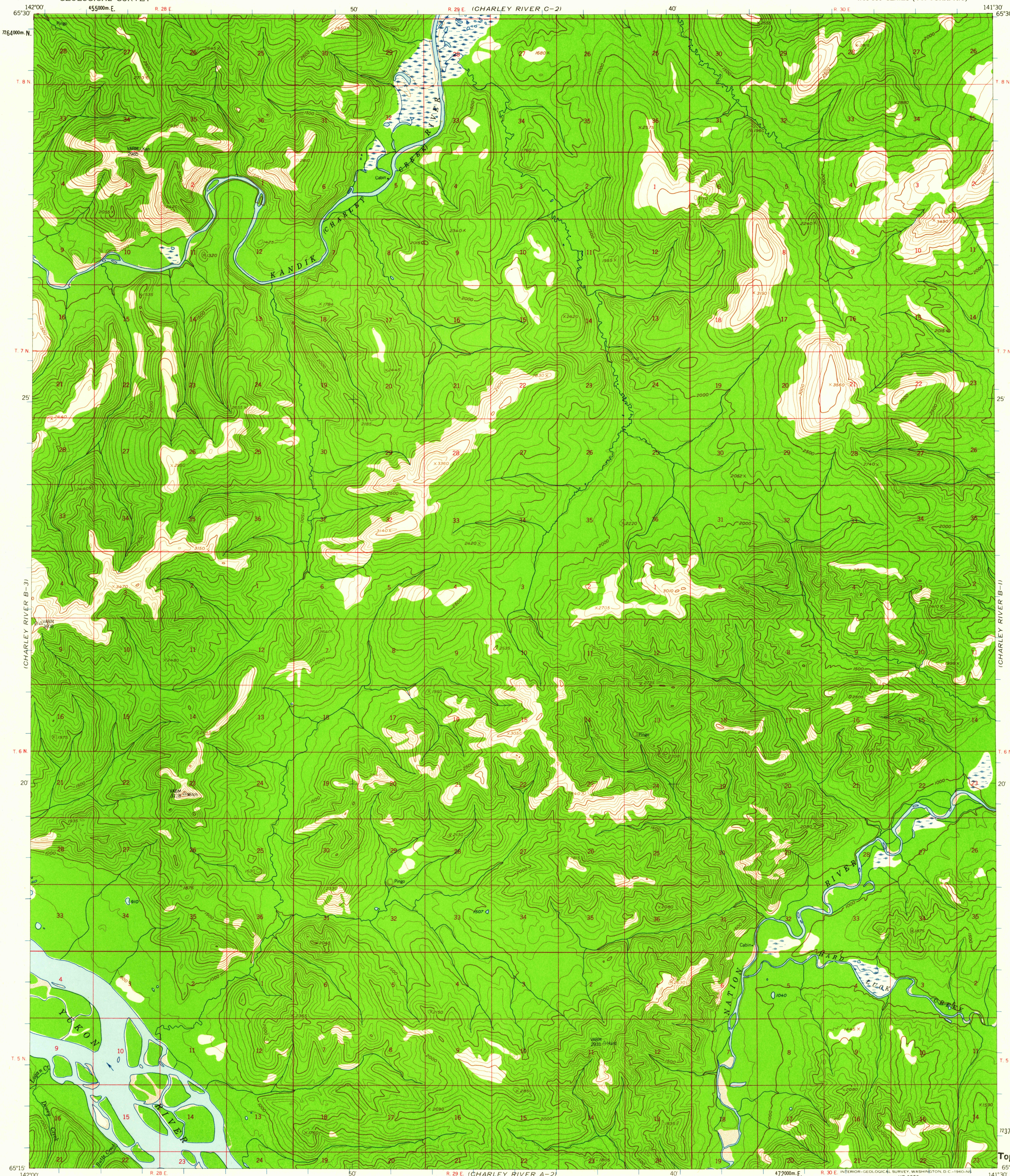

Universal Transverse Mercator projection

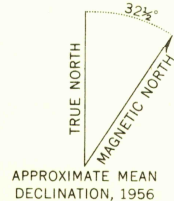

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 7, shown in blue

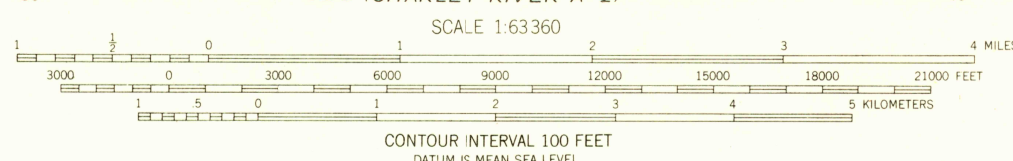

Swamps as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs

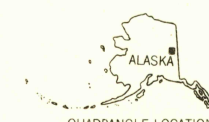
Unchecked elevations are shown in brown and blue
